POSITION OUTLOOK FOR 2016

QUARTERBACKS - In 2014 Clemson had to replace Tajh Boyd, (3851, 69%, 34-11, #2 rush 400). I projected true frosh Deshaun Watson (PS#2, IFS) as the starter but Cole Stoudt started the first 3 with Watson outplaying him in each. Watson then became the first true frosh QB to start at CU in 20 years (school rec 6 TD vs NC). They even un-retired Steve Fuller's #4 jersey. Unfortunately Watson was inj'd vs UL (miss 3). He started vs GT but then was injured again. Watson played with a torn ACL vs SCar (14-19-269) ending their 5 year series losing streak. Watson threw for 1,466 (68%, 14-2). Last year my question with the Clemson QB position was "Can Watson stay healthy?". He answered that question with an emphatic, YES. They limited his running early with under 10 rush att per game the first 5 (238.4 total ypg). Over the last 10 he avg 16.2 rush per game and 401.7 total ypg and was a Heisman finalist. He was the first Division I player to have 4,000 yds passing and 1,000 yds rushing in a single season (478 yds vs Bama). Nick Schuessler (PS#174) had 38 snaps in '14 and was the bkp early last year (5 gm, 13-23-177) while Tucker Israel (5'11" 195, PS#56) used a RS. True frosh Kelly Bryant (PS#27) took over the backup spot and had 156 rush (7-9 pass). They had Watson & Bryant on the field together at times. As long as Watson stays healthy he is a Heisman favorite.

RUNNING BACKS - In 2014 the RB's were very inexp'd. Rfr Tyshon Dye (5'11" 215, PS#20) tore his Achilles in February (4 gm, 151, 4.7). Zac Brooks (PS#29) was OFY in Aug. Their leading rusher after 7 games was true frosh Adam Choice (PS#21) who only played in 6 (218, 4.4). I projected Rfr Wayne Gallman (PS#33) as the starter He had just 198 in the first 7 then he ran for 107 ypg over the L/5 vs Power 5 teams and led with 769 (4.8). With Gallman starting all year in '15 he set the school record for rush yards in a season (1527, 5.4, 1st Tm All-ACC). Brooks was a distant #2 RB (234, 5.7) while Choice RS. This year they only lose Brooks (#7DC SEA) and they could even improve on last year's stats with the addition of PS#1 Tavien Feaster.

RECEIVERS - In 2014 CU had to replace Sammy Watkins (1464, #1DC) and their #2 (Martavis Bryant, 828, 19.7, #4DC). True frosh Artavis Scott (PS#12) led in rec's (#2 yds, 965, 12.7). Scott also broke Watkins' frosh record for rec yds in a game (164 vs SCSt, 185 vs SC). Mike Williams only had 57 rec but was #1 (1030, 18.1). Last year the top 3 were back (all VHT's) but Williams was OFY in the opener. TE Jordan Leggett was a Mackey finalist (first CU TE with TD's in 5 consec gms, #4 w/525, 13.1). Scott had nearly double the catches of #2 Charone Peake (716, 14.3) but only 9.7 ypc (901 yd). True frosh Deon Cain (PS#7) had the best ypc (582, 17.1) while fellow true Ray

Ray McCloud (PS#10) had 251 (8.7). This year they lose Peake (15 st, #7DC NYJ) and Germone Hopper (3 st, 317, 15.1). This unit gets Williams back, is loaded with VHT's and experience and is one of the nation's best.

OFFENSIVE LINE - In '14 they had just 2 returning starters (44 car st). The unit was banged up (6 diff lineups 6 gm stretch) with no CU OL making All-Conf (146, 3.5, 27 sk). Last year they lost 3 starters again (45 car sts ret). Mitch Hyatt (15 sts) became the first true frosh OL to start an opener here s/1944 (Phil Prince). C Ryan Norton was injured in Wk 2 but Jay Guillermo was so good (3X ACC OL of Week) that he held onto the job. The numbers improved (223, 4.9, 18 sk). This year they lose Norton (2/26), 1st Tm ACC LG Eric Mac Lain (15/16, UFA CAR) and 2nd Tm ACC RT Joe Gore (14/17). They have 46 career starts returning and remain one of the best.

DEFENSIVE LINE - In 2014 I had CU rated as my #2 D-line and they played to that level with 6 seniors in the 2 deep (103 ypg rush, 3.0, best s/'06, 36% opp rush 0 or neg yds). They also had 45 sks (most s/'99). Last year they had to replace a pair of AA's (#1, #5 DC) and the 6 DL lost had comb'd for 50 sts, 164 tkl and 20.5 sks. They lost 137 career starts and had just 7 back. I was surprised my computer called for them to only slip to 130 ypg rush & they only allowed 125 (3.5, 48 sk). This year they lose their outstanding DE combo of 1st Tm ACC Shaq Lawson (15 st, 60 tkl, 12.5 sk, 13 tfl, #1DC BUF) and Kevin Dodd (15 st, 62 tkl, 12 sk, 11.5 tfl, #2DC TEN). Also gone is DT DJ Reader who only played in the last 9 (6 st, 13 tkl, 1.5 tfl, #5DC HOU) and DT Roderick Byers (17 tkl, 1 tfl). They lose 25 of the DL's 34 sks but are a little more exp'd than 2015 and add in PS#2 DT 6'5" 340 Dexter Lawrence who was IFS.

LINEBACKERS - LY CU had replace a 1st Tm ACC LB (#1 tkl'r, #1DC) and their #4 tkl'r (#6DC). NB Korrin Wiggins (6 st, 34 tkl '14) was OFY in August. The WLB and MLB spots were manned by Ben Boulware and BJ Goodson who rarely came off the field (#1, #3 tkl'rs). Travis Blanks and Dorian O'Daniel (#8 tkl'r) split the SLB position. LY my computer proj'd (pg 43) they would allow 22.3 ppg and they gave up 21.7. This year they lose 1st Tm ACC BJ Goodson (15 st, #1 tkl'r, 14 tfl, #4DC NYG) and Blanks (12 st, #9 tkl'r). Despite the loss of 2 st'rs including their top guy, they are a little more exp'd and remain solid.

DEFENSIVE BACKS - Last year the Tigers lost a 2nd Tm ACC CB, and a S (#2 tkl'r). One of the 2 returning starters was their shutdown CB Mackensie Alexander who teams rarely threw at (0 int 2Y). Clemson still was a solid #15 in my PDR (48.5%, 19-16). This year they lose 1st Tm ACC CB Alexander (13 st, #12 tkl'r, 5 pbu, #2DC MIN), 2nd Tm ACC S Jayron Kearse (14 st, #5 tkl'r, 6 pbu, #7DC MIN), S TJ Green (15 st, #2 tkl'r, 5.5 tfl, #2DC IND) and Jefferie Gibson (6 tkl). With just 1 starter back they will likely drop some in the PDR.

SPECIAL TEAMS - In '14 new K Ammon Lakip (PS#34) started with 3 misses but finished 21-28 fg (L49). CU avg 5.7 on PR and 18.8 on KR and dropped to #100. Last year they had to replace their 4 year starting LS and star P (#5 DC). Lakip got suspended and just handled KO's (28 TB, 73 KO) and PAT's at the end. Rfr Greg Huegel (Swinney's "grocery store kicker") hit 16 straight FG's (27-32 long 47) but did miss 5 PAT's (10 TB, 37 KO). CU avg just 2.3 on PR's and 21.6 on KR's. Andy Teasdale avg 39.5 (37.4 net) with a SOD fake punt vs NCar then a successful one vs Okla. The unit was just #96 and should make solid strides this year.

COACHES - Dabo Swinney begins his 9th year here with 56 wins in 5 consecutive DD win campaigns, joining Nick Saban as the only HC's to do so. Jeff Scott (here s/'08) and Tony Elliott, who has been the RB cch s/'11 (3Y Furman, 2Y SCSt) are the Co-OC's. Fifth year DC Brent Venables is a rising star as a HC

candidate, while remaining one of the Top 10 paid asst's. He was DC at Okla ('99-'11). Co-OC Marion Hobby (also DE cch) has been in that role s/'11. He was the DC/DL cch at Duke from 2008-'10 and served as Clemson's DE coach in '15. Danny Pearman has been the ST coor/TE cch s/'11.

THIS DECADE 62-19 (76.5%) #11 - In '11, coming off a 6-7 season, Clemson made my Most Improved List. They became the first ACC team to knock off ranked foes in 3 consec wks and won their first ACC Title in 20 years. The 10 win season was their first s/'90 and they made it to their first ever BCS bowl (lost 70-33). In '12 CU had 14 returning starters and opened 10-1 (lone loss to FSU). They led rival SC 14-10 at half but lost by 10. They trailed 9 LSU 24-13 in the bowl but rallied for a 25-24 win and #11 finish. In '13 they ret'd QB Boyd, WR Watkins and 10 other st'rs. They were AP #3 for 5 str wks but at 6-0, lost to #5 FSU at home 51-14. Later they lost to SC for a 5th straight year but did beat Ohio St in the bowl (11-2 #8). In 2014 they were #1 in total defense but they did lose to Georgia by 24, #1 Florida St in OT without QB Jameis Winston and to GTech by 22 but beat Okla in the Orange Bowl to finish 10-3 and #15. Last year they were #1 going into the playoffs and came up just short vs Bama in the Title Game. They are 62-19 this decade which is the 11th best.

2015 ANALYSIS 14-1 - Dabo Swinney did a great job LY, especially on D with just 3 returning starters. Clemson got 2 blowout wins to open the season then L'ville missed a 38 yd FG w/2:28 left (3 pt road win). ND outgained them 432-296 but CU was +3 in TO's and stopped a 2 pt conv to escape with a 2 pt win in constant rain. They won their next 4 by 27 ppg. Florida St led 10-6 3Q but were -2 in TO's and SOD at midfield late. CU got a TD and a 10 pt win. CU was #1 in the country after Wk 10 and won their last 3 before surviving a controversial onside kick vs NCar in the ACC Champ gm. They trailed Okla 17-16 3Q but won 37-17. Clemson was impressive in the Title Game with 550 yards vs the Tide defense but trailed 45-33 until a TD with :12 left to come up just short.

PHIL'S FORECAST

OFFENSE - Alabama would have finished #1 in total defense last year had it not been for Clemson gashing them for 550 yds in the Title Game. Clemson returns 8 starters from an offense that avg a school rec 515 ypg. They were the first team in ACC history with 3,000 yds rushing and 4,000 yds passing (34 rush, 35 pass td). QB Watson is the Heisman frontrunner, they get WR Williams back from injury and my computer is calling for 41.9 ppg and 550 ypg this year.

DEFENSE - The Tigers led the nation in total defense in 2014 allowing just 261 ypg and allowed just 313 ypg in '15 despite just 3 starters back. They have led the nation in tfl's the last 3 years and were Top 5 in 3rd down stops during that span. They rotate a lot of players on D so they will be tough again despite just 4 returning starters.

2016 - This is a relatively young team with just 22 upperclassmen. 17 players were selected either 1st, 2nd or 3rd Tm ACC LY and 11 of them return. Clemson had a 31-18 FD edge vs Alabama in the National Title game and will have one of the top offenses in the country. Their +267 ypg in ACC play was more than triple the #2 ranked ACC team. Three of their 5 road games are vs teams with losing records last year. October 29th is the key game on the schedule (at Florida St) and they will be favored in all their other games. Dabo Swinney is doing a great job (see pg 343) and this team is a legitimate National Title contender again this year.

LTH ('10) CU lost 27-24 (last win in Auburn was in 1950). CU led 17-3 at HT but eventually lost in OT vs #16 AU. CU has won 4 of their L5 road openers incl '12's win (L/mtg) vs AU in the Georgia Dome.

CU won 43-19 in 11's home opener (only prior mtg). Tigers are 27-2 in home openers (12 str wins by 24 ppg). Excluding rival SC, CU has won 18 str home gms vs non-conf foes, L/loss vs #15 TCU in '09).

Tigers are 3-0 (all gms since '08) w/a avg score 60-7 incl a 73-7 win in the L/mtg ('14). 10th str ssn CU plays a FCS program (9-0, avg win by 36 ppg). Bulldogs went 7-4 LY (did not face a FBS school).

Visitor has now lost 10 of the L/11 meetings. LTH GT pulled the 28-6 upset with the key play being an 85 yd IR to 3 plays after CU QB Watson was inj'd. It marks the Tigers last reg ssn loss into '16.

CU has won 7 of the L/8 meetings incl 5 str. LTH the Tigers had 22-11 FD and 398-263 yd edges but only won 17-13. BC had a chance for the upset but their L/drive stalled at the CU31 w/49 left.

LY after the first 4 drives it was 13-13 (each blk'd an XP). CU took the lead for good :40 before HT on a 42 yd td pass, 26-20. NCST got as close as 6 mid-3Q but CU answered w/B2B td drives & answered both 4Q td's.

Bonus: Of the 128 FBS HC's, 6 have won a National Title & Swinney has a victory over 5 of them.

CU is 9-20 (L/won 2 str from '05-'07, 3 str wins & only series winning streak). LTH CU looked to have the gm in reg but fmbld at the FSU14 w/1:36 left. In OT, CU was SOD & FSU got a 12 yd td run.

LY Watson had a then career high 473 ttd yds (later broke mark vs Bama w/478). The gm was 14-14 in a wild first 11:26. SU only trailed by 7 w/10:18 left but after all'g a fg punted & CU ran out L/5:57.

The only prior meeting was the 1977 Gator Bowl, Clemson lost 34-3. Into '16, the Tigers have won 9 str ACC home gms by 18 ppg (L/loss in '13 vs #5 FSU).

LTH despite a 427-119 yd edge, they were tied at 20 in the 4Q before CU put the gm away w/a 68 yd td pass & 30 yd td run.

114th mtg, played every ssn s/1909. LY CU got off to a slow start (ACC Title on deck) but still led 14-3 at HT. CU all'd a 26/4pl td after a fmbld & only led 28-25 w/12:19 left. CU put the gm away w/a td, SOD at SC10 & a fg (SC's L/td w/0:1).
