POSITION OUTLOOK FOR 2016

QUARTERBACKS - In 2012 Andrew Luck joined fellow Cardinal QB's Bobby Garrett, Jim Plunkett and John Elway in being selected as the #1 overall pick in the NFL draft. Three VHT QB's battled to replace him. Kevin Hogan (PS#18) ran some Wildcat packages early in '12, then took over full-time. He went 5-0 as a s/r (4 ranked tms: #1, #13, #15 & #17). His mobility (#2 rusher w/263) gave D's another wrinkle to prepare for. Hogan completed 72% (1096, 9-3). In '13 his comp % dropped, partially due to losing his imposing TE's and throwing downfield more (2630, 61%, 20-10, #2 rush w/355). Hogan did not have the season that many expected in '14 (2792, 66%, 19-8). R/R Ryan Burns (PS#12) played in 2 gm (1 pass) while Keller Chryst (6'5" 237) had been drawing some comparisons to Luck. Hogan, despite a sprained ankle vs USC, threw for 2,867 (67.8%, 27-8, 336 rush) last year. Chryst only played in 4 (9 pass att). This unit is vastly less exp'd with the loss of their team leader (#5DC KC, schl record 35 wins as starter, Luck 32) and just 10 career pass attempts back. I still think they can come close to 2015's numbers, however.

RUNNING BACKS - Toby Gerhart, Stepan Taylor and Tyler Gaffney (1709, 5.2, 21 td '13) comb'd for 6 straight 1,000 yd seasons (all were draft picks). In '14 they didn't have anyone like the 220 lb Gaffney and replaced him with smaller backs. Remound Wright (PS#25) had twice as many carries as any other RB but finished with just 601 (4.5). Barry Sanders Jr was #3 (315, 5.3) while true frosh Christian McCaffrey (PS#14) had 300 (7.1). McCaffrey bulked up in '15 and almost won the Heisman Trophy (#2). He ironically broke Barry Sanders' FBS record for all-purp yds in a season and set the schl single gm rush record with 243 vs UCLA (Gerhart 223 '09). He was the first SU RB to top 100 rush & rec in the same game (Wash) s/91 (Glyn Milburn) and McCaffrey went on to accomplish that feat two more times during the season (L/2). He had a schl rec 389 all-purp yds vs Cal then 461 in the Pac-12 Title game (won Paul Horning award). McCaffrey led with 2,019 (1st FBS, 6.0, #1 rec) and Sanders Jr was #3 (315, 6.2). True frosh RB Bryce Love (PS#27) had a 48 yd TD run and 93 yd TD rec (476 tld yds) while Cameron Scarlett (6'1" 216, PS#33) used a RS and walk-on Pat McCadden (5'10" 194 Jr) earned 3 rush att vs Arizona. They lose short ydg back Wright (239, 2.9, 13 td) and Sanders Jr but McCaffrey is clearly a Heisman frontrunner.

RECEIVERS - LY the Cardinal lost their #1 guy (#3DC GB). They had great size with 6 guys at 6'3" or better. Francis Owusu made a remarkable catch (arms around UCLA DB and still held on) but was only #6 (175, 13.5). Michael Rector was the top WR

(559, 16.4) with TE Austin Hooper finishing #3 (438, 12.9). TY they lose Devon Cajuste (12 st, 383, 14.2, UFA SF), Hooper (#3DC ATL) and Rollins Stallworth (1 st, 7 rec). Despite a new QB, this unit could top '15's production with their 4 VHT's.

OFFENSIVE LINE - Stanford's 2014 performance illustrates why I use experience ratings. From '09-'13 SU's O-line created holes for the top 5 rush totals in school history. In '13 with 9 of the top 10 back (84 car sts) they had 207 ypg rush (5.0, 16 sk). In 2014 they had to replace a 1st Tm AA 3Y LG (#5DC), 1st Tm P12 3Y RT (#4DC), 3rd Tm P12 2Y C, 3rd Tm P12 2Y RG and had just 26 career starts back. SU dropped to 159 rush ypg (4.3) with 23 sacks (most all'd s/07). Last year they lost a 2nd Tm AA LT (#1DC) but returned 9 of the talented top 10 incl 2nd Tm P12 OT Kyle Murphy (car sts rose to 65). SU improved to 224 ypg rush (5.1, 20 sk). This year they lose the Outland Trophy winner in LG Joshua Garnett (14/32, #1DC SF), 1st Tm P12 LT Murphy (14/34, #6DC GB), C Graham Shuler (14/27) and 2 bkps. They have just 40 car sts back but are very talented (9 VHT's) and well coached.

DEFENSIVE LINE - This unit was thin and had to replace all 3 starters in 2015 (#3, #5 DC's). The top returnees were PS#19 Aziz Shittu (13 tkl, 1 sk) and Harrison Phillips (9 tkl, 2 sk as true). They did add in Cal transfer Brennan Scarlett (9 st '12, 5 st inj '14). When I went over the team with HC David Shaw in the spring we got to the 5th DL and that was about it. Many times they play a 2-man front, bringing a LB down. They then lost NT Harrison Phillips in the opener! The worst rush D in Shaw's first 4 yrs was just 3.1 ypc but LY it was 140 (4.3, 34 sk). This year they lose DE Shittu (#2 tkl'r, 14 st, 4 sk, 10 tfl) and Scarlett (13 st, 37 tkl, 5.5 sk). Normally when a team loses two of the top 3 they are weaker but with Solomon Thomas back (39 tkl, 10.5 tfl) and Phillips returning from injury, they are deeper and more exp'd. They also add in 4 quality true frosh and will improve on 2015's poor (for them) numbers.

LINEBACKERS - Last year the Cardinal again lost 2 starting LB's (#2, #6 tkl'r's). They ret'd 3rd Tm P12 Blake Martinez (#1 tkl'r) along with their #5 (5.5 sk) and #11 (6.5 sk) tkl'r's but unlike '14, did not lose any AA's. One of the 3 ret st's on D, Kevin Anderson (tm captain) missed 4 games (#8 tkl'r, 8.5 tfl). Martinez was 1st Tm P12 (#1 tkl'r, 6.5 tfl) while soph Peter Kalamabayi (PS#12) was the #5 tkl'r. My computer projected a slip from 16.4 ppg in '14 to 21.3 and they allowed 22.6. TY they lose 2 starters again in Martinez (14 st, 2nd Tm AA, #4DC GB) and Anderson (9 st, UFA SF). They return their #5, #6 and #9 tkl'r's and will be a top-notch unit again.

DEFENSIVE BACKS - In '14 with 3 st's back Stanford finished #6 (57%, 12-12) in my PDR. LY they lost 3.5 st's incl #2 and #3 DC's (both left early for NFL) and their FS Zach Hoffpaur (11 st, 44 tkl) signed a baseball contract. They still finished #3 (57.3%, 19-8). TY they lose CB Ronnie Harris (12 st, #12 tkl'r, 10 pbu) and FS Kodi Whitfield (14 st, #4 tkl'r, 3 pd). Four different frosh earned starts LY and their S's were a converted WR and QB. In '16 they have 5 of the top 7 back and Hoffpaur also returns making them much more exp'd.

SPECIAL TEAMS - In 2013, then-2nd year ST coach Pete Alamar won my ST COY Award as SU finished #1 in my ST rankings. In 2014 they had everyone back but surprisingly slipped to #67. Last year all of the ST leaders departed but I said, "Alamar usually molds a fine group, so they should move up." McCaffrey had 1,070 KR yds (28.9) but just 130 (8.7) on PR's. Conrad Ukropina hit 18-20 FG's (long 52) including the split vs ND. Alex Robinson and true frosh Jake Bailey (PS#9) swt the punting duties (40.8, tm net 37.2). Bailey & Ukropina combined for 18 TB on 96 KO's. The unit moved up to #6 and has everyone back so it will contend for the top honors.

COACHES - David Shaw has been as good as advertised on "The Farm", leading the Cardinal to 11+ win seasons in 4 of his 5 years as HC, keeping the momentum flowing after Jim Harbaugh left for the 49ers. Shaw served as Harbaugh's OC here from '07-'10. He spent the previous 10 years as an NFL off asst (PHI, OAK, BAL, SD) and is also the 5th alum (4Y left at WR) to be a HC here. Mike Bloomgren (Jets asst '07-'10) was the OL coach here in '11 & '12 and was promoted to OC in 2013. Shaw promoted Lance Anderson to the DC in 2014. He was at the Univ of San Diego ('05-'06) under Harbaugh and has been here s/07 (3Y DT cch, 4Y OLB cch).

THIS DECADE 66-15 (81.5%) #5 - Harbaugh and now Shaw have done a remarkable job turning the Stanford program around. In the 7 years prior to Harbaugh's arrival ('07), SU had 3 diff HC's and he inherited a team that was the worst in the P12 at -169 ypg (89 yds worse than #9) and had tied a SU rec with 11 straight losses (1959-'60). Harbaugh had two losing seasons but then SU made my Most Improved List in '09 and moved up to 8-5. They had their 6th ever Top 10 finish in '10 (4th, 1st s/92) at 12-1, which was 2nd highest in tm history (#2 in '40). Shaw exceeded my expectations in '11 as they went 11-2 only losing to #6 Oregon and #3 Okla St (2 miss fg, lost in OT in the bowl). The Cardinal had to replace Luck in '12 but Shaw outdid my expectations again at 12-2 (#7). They had their highest preseason ranking ever in '13 (#4). They beat Ariz St for the P12 Title 38-14 but lost the Rose Bowl, their 3rd loss of the year (most s/09) and fell to #11. In '14 they had to play Wash, ND, Ariz St, Oregon and UCLA on the road and only had 12 ret st's and finished 8-5 (NR, all 5 losses to rank tms). LY they rebounded to 12-2 (#3).

2015 ANALYSIS 12-2 - Stanford was my #1 Surprise Team a year go as they had a lot of factors in their favor. If not for an opening day loss at Northwestern, they would have made the playoffs despite entering the year #21 AP. After that loss they rebounded to win their next 8 including an upset at #6 USC. Stanford was stopped on a gm-tying 2 pt conv and fumbled on their previous 2 drives and lost to Oregon at home by 2 despite a 506-436 yard edge. Stanford did need a 45 yard FG with :00 left to get past ND at home. The Cardinal whipped USC 41-22 in the Pac-12 Title game and led a 12-1 Iowa team 38-0 late 3Q in a dominating Rose Bowl win. They were 12-2 and despite not being in the playoffs, finished #3 in the country.

PHIL'S FORECAST

OFFENSE - McCaffrey and a 4th year starting QB helped the Cardinal offense improve from 27.2 ppg to 37.8, their best s/'11 (Luck, 43.2). Hogan is gone as are 3 starters on the O-line & 2 of the top 3 rec's. McCaffrey is back and Shaw has plenty of VHT's to plug in with the 5 returning starters. My computer calls for a small drop to 34.6 ppg.

DEFENSE - Stanford had a very inexp'd defense LY with just 3 ret st's and little depth up front. It was not your typical Stanford defense as they allowed 22.6 ppg and 368 ypg, both their most s/2009. While they have some losses, they basically have 7 ret st's (get back FS Hoffpaur) and this will more resemble your typical (strong) Cardinal defense.

2016 - If I did not list Stanford as my #1 Surprise Team LY, they probably would not have been ranked in the preseason. They were #21 AP preseason. They have a stronger defense and a Heisman-caliber RB in McCaffrey and two very capable VHT QB's ready to fill Hogan's shoes. The Cardinal are a stronger team than '15's version which finished #3 and won the Pac-12 Title game and Rose Bowl by 24 ppg. Their schedule is the toughest in the country as they face ND, UCLA, Wash and Oregon all on the road. With the most talented team in the Pac-12 and Shaw as HC, Stanford is clearly a National Title contender.

Oregon St: (continued from Nov. 5) The Cardinal then went 81 & 55 yds for B2B td's. Up 11 in the 4Q Stanford put the gm away w/a 65 yd td run.

SU beat USC twice LY. In reg ssn, SU led by 7 w/19 left sealing it w/a 52/11 pl fg drive (6:47 TOP). In P12 Title gm SU led 27-22 w/12/29 left sealing it w/B2B td drives of 75 & 37 yds (L with 1:38).
