POSITION OUTLOOK FOR 2016

QUARTERBACKS - Casey Pachall broke Andy Dalton's single season passing records (2921, 67%, 25-7) in '11. Pachall was #1 in the NCAA in pass efficiency (948, 66%, 10-1) in '12 prior to being susp. Trevone Boykin (PS#59, 4.5 spd) threw for 2,054 (57%, 15-10, 417 rush). Pachall started just 6 (inj) in '13 (1468, 56%, 6-10) with Boykin starting the rest (1198, 60%, 7-7, 313 rush) and played some WR (#5, 204, 7.8). In '14 HC Patterson hoped another QB would step up and allow Boykin to move to WR/RB/RM. Boykin beat out 2VHT's and played beyond expectations (Heisman finalist, 3901, 61%, 33-10, #2 rusher). In '14 they added 2 QB's recruited for the offense in Foster Sawyer (PS#31) and Grayson Muehlstein (PS#49). LY Boykin (TCU's all-time leading passer) would have been a Heisman finalist had it not been for an injury (miss OU). Sawyer hit just 11-27. Bram Kohlhausen led the comeback vs OU & started & won vs Oregon (Boykin susp) with a big 2H. Boykin's (UFA SEA) play-making ability & leadership will be missed as will Kohlhausen (comb 36-12 ratio). TCU adds Kenny Hill (PS#26) who threw for 2,649 (67%, 23-8) and was an early Heisman candidate at A&M in '14. He is a solid fit for this offense.

RUNNING BACKS - Patterson used a RB-by-committee in '14. QB Boykin was the #1 rusher early on, BJ Catalan was #1 after 8 (493, 5.0) but OFY vs WV. Neb transfer Aaron Green (PS#8) had 544 yds over the final 5 to lead w/922 (7.1, 221 lb rFr Trevorris Johnson (PS#61) meanwhile was the power back (302, 5.7) and rFr Kyle Hicks (PS#23) added 160 (3.5). Last year Green topped 160 three different times and led with 1,272 (5.2). Johnson (262, 6.1) and Hicks (262, 4.8) were way back tying at #3 (Boykin #2). This year they bring in WR Shaun Nixon (PS#19) and a pair of true frosh (PS#54 & 57). They lose their top guy Green (UFA LA) but I like the replacements which should allow them to come close to '15's numbers.

RECEIVERS - In 2013 Josh Doctson led with just 440 (12.2). In 2014, Doctson in the new offense led with 1,018 (15.7) despite injuries. Kolby Listenbee (10.1 100M fastest ever for an FBS player) finished #2 (753, 18.4). Explosive Deante Gray was #2 before being injured vs WV (#3, 582, 16.2, 8 td). Doctson was one of the top 2 WR's in the FBS in '15 but was OFY after 11 gms. He still set school rec's with 79 rec, 1,327 yds and 14 td's. True frosh KaVontae Turpin was #2 with 649, (14.4). This year they lose 1st Tm AA Doctson (TCU's all-time leading rec, 11 st, #1DC WAS), Listenbee (10 st, 597, 19.9, #6DC BUF) along with 3 bkps (comb 6 st, 13 rec) and Nixon (moves to RB, #4 rec). They add in LSU transfer John Diarse (PS#27), PS#8 and PS#8 JUCO's, plus get back Gray and Ty Slanina (#2 rec when inj'd '15) so they should remain an elite unit despite losing two premier players.

OFFENSIVE LINE - Patterson usually does well here, even with inexp'd O-lines (see '13 mag). Last year they lost a 3rd Tm B12 LT (#7DC) but had 9 of the top 10 back (98 car sts ret) and they were solid again (215, 5.0, 18 sk). This year they lose 2nd Tm B12 C Joey Hunt (10/36, #6DC SEA), RG Brady Foltz (12/25), Jamelle Naff (10/25), 2nd Tm B12 LT Halapoulivaati Vaitai (11/31, #5DC PHI), and backup Bobby Thompson. Soph's Matt Pryor and Austin Schlottman both started the final 3 (Okla, Baylor, Oregon) with Naff and Hunt inj'd. They also get back Collins and add in a PS#61 JC (IFS). The career starts ret drop to 46 but this is one of those inexp'd O-lines that Patterson has had so much success in molding and they are more exp'd than the one returning starter would indicate.

DEFENSIVE LINE - Gary Patterson knows defenses and his run D's here at TCU all'd an avg 96 ypg and just 2.7 ypc. LY they lost a 2nd Tm B12 DT but ret'd 8 of their top 9 incl Bowl Def MVP James McFarland (led DL's w/7 sk) while also adding in Aaron Curry (8 st at Neb '13). McFarland (inj) DNP and TCU slipped to 183 ypg rush (4.2, 32 sk). TY they lose 1st Tm B12 NT Davion Pierson (9 st, 37 tkl, 2 sk), DE Terrell Lathan (4 st, 34 tkl, 4 sk) and DE Mike Tuava (8 st, 26 tkl, 2.5 tfl). LY's numbers were poor (inexp LB's part of that) and with the return of McFarland they are more exp'd (4 DL w/6+ sts in a ssn) and will be much tougher vs the run.

LINEBACKERS - TCU runs a 4-2-5 but I include the SS in this write-up since it's the closest to a LB. LY they lost a 1st Tm AA (#10 tkl/r in FBS w/136, #3DC), a 3rd Tm B12 LB (#2 tkl/r) a 1st Tm B12 SS (#5 tkl/r) and their #4 tkl/r. They had 96 car sts lost and 0 car sts ret (just 59 tkl) and was my biggest ? of the '15 team. Patterson said the unit was much faster (top 5 LB's avg 4.54). Sammy Douglas was OFY after 1 start. Their other LB (Mike Freeze) quit after 1 start. RFr Ty Summers did well late (23 tkl vs Baylor) and finished #3. SS Travin Howard moved to MLB (#1 tkl/r) while HM Tm B12 SS Denzel Johnson was #4. TCU slipped to yielding 27.2 ppg (highest s/O4). The unit returns intact so they go from a ? to a strength.

DEFENSIVE BACKS - TCU has had nine Top 10 finishes in my PDR over the last 10 yrs including #1 (48.5%, 17-26) in '14! LY they lost a 1st Tm B12 FS (#4 tkl/r) and 2nd Tm B12 CB (#6 tkl/r). SS Kenny Iloka (PS#106 JC) was OFY after Wk 2 while CB Ranthony Texada (13 st '14) was OFY Wk 3. Patterson did a great job again and they finished #9 (49.8%, 17-7). TY they lose 1st Tm B12 FS Derrick Kindred (13 st, #2 tkl/r, #4DC CLE) and CB Corry O'Meally (8 st, #8 tkl/r, 10 pbu). While the top guy is gone, they go from 1 ret starter to 2 (Texada returns). They add in a PS#49JC and it should be another Top 10 finish.

SPECIAL TEAMS - One sure sign of a solid HC is excellent ST's. For 11 straight yrs TCU has ranked in the Top 50 of my ST rankings (avg #23). LY 4 year P Ethan Perry avg 39.0 (36.6 m net, opp PR 23 yds L2Y!). Four year starter K Jaden Oberkorn hit 21-25 FG's (tied TCU rec w/57 ydr). He broke Nick Brown's career mark of 65 FG ('01-'03) and had 56 TB on 92 KO. TCU has ret'd either a PR or KR for a td in 8 of the last 9 yrs (1 PR '15). True frosh KaVontae Turpin was the top KR (27.0) and PR (10.6). TY they lose their long time K & P but with Patterson's history, they could stay in the Top 50.

COACHES - Gary Patterson took over as HC in Fort Worth in 2000 and has produced 10 DD win seasons in his 15 yrs! Patterson won 10 diff HC awards in '14 (12-1 #3). The 3rd yr co-OC's are Doug Meacham (co-OC Houston '13, 8Y asst at Okla St) and Sonny Cumbie who spent 5 years at TT (co-OC in '13). Chad Glasgow becomes the sole DC here, having shared the role w/DeMontie Cross in '15. Glasgow was the DB chg here from '01-'10, returning in '12 to cch secondary (DC at TT '11). Eric Russell enters his 2nd season guiding the TCU ST's.

THIS DECADE 58-19 (75.3%) #12 - TCU went 48-7 in MW play and in '09 if Texas had missed a long fg vs Nebraska in the B12 Title gm, TCU would have been in the National Title game. In '10 eight of my 9 sets of PR's called for TCU to go 12-0 and I was the ONLY magazine that had them ranked higher than Boise St. TCU went a perfect 13-0 (+313 ypg MW) finishing #2 AP (three #1 votes). They were just 11-14 their first 2 years in the Big 12. In '14 TCU accomplished the almost unthinkable making both my Most Improved (#1) and Surprise Team (#4) lists. That's rarefied air for a team coming off a 4-8 season. TCU led Baylor by 21 in the 4Q but suffered a tough loss which kept them out of the playoffs. They destroyed #9 Ole Miss 42-3 in the Peach Bowl to finish 12-1 (#3). LY they opened #2 AP and finished 11-2 (#7). They are 58-19 this decade.

2015 ANALYSIS 11-2 - LY TCU had 14 ret st's (incl 9 on off). They were #2 in the AP poll (NR '14 picked 7th B12 media). TCU got past Minn by 6 in the opener. At 3-0 they needed a tipped pass (:29 left) on 4th down in the EZ to beat TT. TCU destroyed Texas 50-7 but then needed a TD with 1:10 left to get past K-St by 7. TCU whipped Iowa St and WV and at 8-0 were #5. They had a 36-16 FD edge at Okla St but lost by 20 due to being -4 in TO's. Boykin was hurt early vs Kansas and they only won at home by 6. Without Boykin & WR Doctson, they trailed at Oklahoma 23-7 at half. QB Kohlhausen led a comeback as TCU got a TD with :51 left and went for the win but the 2 pt conv failed. Boykin was back and they beat Baylor in a monsoon 28-21. Boykin was susp for the bowl and they trailed 31-0 at half. Oregon then lost its QB, and most importantly, Patterson changed his shirt at halftime. TCU rallied for a 30T win (545-419 yd edge) led by Kohlhausen to finish 11-2 and #7.

PHIL'S FORECAST

OFFENSE - TCU has adapted to the Texas Tech offense in a remarkable way going from 25.1 ppg to an avg 44.3 ppg the L2Y. The numbers show TCU with just 3 st's back on offense but they are MUCH more experienced than that with the addition of QB Hill, 2 super JC's and an LSU VHT at WR. They also have an O-line that has 3 st's back from the final 3 gms (also get back 23 gm starter Aviante Collins who missed LY). Usually when a team goes from 9 ret st's to 3 there is a large drop off, but that won't be the case for the Horned Frogs this year.

DEFENSE - The TCU defense was an injury plagued unit in '15 and allowed 27.2 ppg and 398 ypg (highest s/O4). Not only do they have 8 returning starters but they get back all the injured players like DL James McFarland (bowl MVP '14), CB Texada (13 st '14) and Kenny Iloka. This defense will resemble more of what you would expect a Patterson D to look like.

2016 - TCU was NR in '14 coming off a 4-8 season but made my Surprise Team List and nearly got to the Title game. Expectations were much higher LY at #2 preseason but due to a large amount of injuries to key players, they were "just" 11-2 and #7. They did have 5 net close wins LY (pg 24), have a Stock Market Indicator of -3.0 and are -41 All Conf Points (pg 33), all factors pointing down. I have already seen them picked as low as 6th.....in the Big 12! They will not be in the Top 10 TY but they do make my Surprise Team List again which is a non Top 10 team I consider a National Title contender. The last time they were on that list they almost made the playoffs and finished #3 in the country.

First mtg. TCU has won 14 str home openers. HC Patterson lost his first HG to NWST (in OT) but is 9-0 since vs FCS tms winning by 44 ppg. Jackrabbits went 8-4 LY (#15 FCS playoffs) incl a 41-38 win over KU.

69th mtg. Both played in the SWC from 1923-'91. TCU is 3-30 incl a 22-21 loss in L/mtg ('91). Last time TCU dropped a non-conf HG vs a P5 tm was in '99 (lost vs AZ), since they are 9-0 incl 2-0 as B12 members.

The Horned Frogs are 6-1 (3-1 in B12). LY TCU trailed 21-14 after 1Q but over the L/3Q's held ISU scoreless although the Cyclones ended 5 of their L/7 poss in TCU territory (2 fmb's, a punt & 2 SOD).

Frogs have won 14 of L/16. LTH's win was the most lopsided in the 95 gm history. SMU did end 6 drives on TCU1 (SOD), TCU30 (SOD), sk/fmb'l at SMU44, int at TCU47, sk/fmb'l at SMU22 & EOG at TCU5.

LY TCU was w/o its st's QB/WR. OU led 23-7 at HT & 30-13 (24 pts off 4 TCU TO's) w/under 10 min left. TCU got a 86 yd td pass, fg & 14 yd td pass w/51 left. Down 1 they went for the win (2ptng, pass incl).

LTH TCU was sitting at #4 in the playoff rankings. TCU trailed 27-17 late 3Q but they got 2 td's (24 yd pass & 69 yd PR) to lead into the 4Q. Up 4, TCU int'd Kansas at their 49 & ran out the L/3:26.

Bonus: The Horned Frogs are 8-3 in road openers winning by an avg 17 ppg (avg loss 11 ppg).

LTH saw the series' 3rd str gm decided on final play. TCU trailed 30-21 w/14:56 left. After cutting it to 2, TCU was SOD at WV43 but forced a punt w/2:07. Seven plays later TCU hit a GW 37 yd fg as time exp'd.

59th mtg. LY saw 4 lead changes in the L/4 scores (all 4Q). Down 52-48 TCU went 53/9pl & on 4th&G from the TT4 w/23 tossed a pass that was tipped by a WR into RB Green's hand's in the back of the EZ.

TCU is 5-3 since their SWC days. LTH BU kicked a 28 yd fg (only lead of the gm) as time exp'd wiping out a 21 pt deficit in the L/10:39. TCU blew 4 separate DD leads incl being up 58-37 after a 49 yd IR td.

Bonus: The Horned Frogs are 14-3 in home finales but are just 2-2 the last 4 years.

HT is 9-1-1 (27th overall mtg). LY TCU trailed 35-9 early 3Q in the battle of 8-0 squads. TCU's most lopsided loss in 2+ yrs.

LTH's 38 pt MOV was largest s/78. Thanksgiving. TCU led 13-0 into 2Q & 27-3 4Q, ending the scoring on a 33 yd IR td.

HT is 6-3 all-time. LY TCU trailed 42-31 w/under 8 min to play.

Tied 45-45 TCU got a 55 yd td pass w/1:10 left for the win.
