

MICHIGAN WOLVERINES



POSITION OUTLOOK FOR 2016

QUARTERBACKS - In '13 Shane Morris started in the bowl (29-47-261-0-2) after backing up Devin Gardner during the reg ssn. In '14 Morris started vs Minn but hit just 14-40 (career 0-5 ratio). LY I proj'd Iowa transfer Jake Rudock (25 st, 4819, 60%, 34-18) to beat him out. Morris was #1 out of spring but RS. I said they could only improve upon their 10-18 ratio as Jim Harbaugh 1st year QB's in college avg 2,584 (21-8). Rudock threw for 184 ypg the first 8 but then 324 ypg over the last 5 and led the Big Ten in comp % (64%). Wilton Speight (PS#24) played in 7 (9-25-73-1-1) while Alex Malzone (6'11" 222 rF, PS#16) committed to previous HC Brady Hoke. TY Speight had the edge out of spring but I expect transfer John O'Korn to win the job. He had 16 sts at Houston (see stats below) and was impressive on the scout team in '15. Despite losing their starter (Rudock #6DC DET), they could be just as good.

RUNNING BACKS - UM had had only one 1,000 yd RB since '07. In '14 Derrick Green (PS#2) was joined by DeVone Smith (PS#31) and soph Drake Johnson (PS#87). Green was #1 in the first 6 (471, 5.7) before being OFY. Johnson had 122 vs Ind and led in the final 2 finishing w/361 (6.0). LY they added in Ty Isaac (PS#4, 236, 5.9 true USC). Johnson was inj'd early and Smith was clearly the top guy with 126 vs Oregon St and 125 vs BYU. He was then banged up and did not top 100 again until the bowl (753, 4.2). Isaac had 114 vs UNLV but got in the doghouse and missed the L/6 gms (205, 6.8). Johnson was #2 (271, 5.0) while Karan Higdon (5'10" 189, PS#56) saw limited action as a true (11 carries). TY they lose Green (157, 3.3) as well as both FB's in Sione Houma (184, 4.3) and Joe Kerridge (62, 4.4). They do add in PS#2 Kareem Walker and PS#56 Kingston Davis (both IFS). I look for big time improvement from the UM RB's.

RECEIVERS - In '14 the top returning WR was Jehu Chesson (PS#61, 221, 14.7). TE Jake Butt tore his ACL in the spg but ret'd Wk 3 and actually started 5 (#3, 211, 10.0). Amara Darboh has size and speed and was #2 (473, 13.1). LY they had to replace their #1 guy (#2DC, 733, 11.8). Darboh was #1 most of the year (727, 12.5). The 6'3" Chesson had 207 vs Ind, 111 vs Ohio St and lit up Florida's Vernon Hargreaves for 118 in the bowl to finish #1 (764, 15.3). Butt was steady all year (654, 12.8). True frosh Grant Perry had 5-51 in the bowl. They lose TE AJ Williams (3 st, 12 rec) but add in true frosh Ahmir Mitchell (PS#21) who was awarded jersey #2. With the top 4 back and added talent, this is a top notch group.

OFFENSIVE LINE - When Brady Hoke arrived he had just 8 schlp OL's and they were recruited for Rich Rod's spread offense. Hoke craved a pro-style offense and in '13 was up to 15 schlp OL (only 2 Sr's, 10 frosh). In '14 the car sts ret dropped (37) for a 2nd str yr (lost #1, #3 DC T's). Mason Cole (PS#17) became the first true frosh in schl line to open the year at LT.

UM showed improvement (163, 4.6, 26 sk). LY they had 4 st's back (76 car st). All 5 st's started all 13 but with a new system the numbers were about the same (158, 4.2, 18 sk). TY they lose their starting C for a 5th straight year in Graham Glasgow (13/37 st, #3DC DET) but have 9 of the top 10 back (105 car st) which will show in the numbers.

DEFENSIVE LINE - LY they lost both DE's (#2DC, 20 st, 10 sk). They had 7 VHT's back that made the 2 deep at times in '14. Proj str DT Bryan Mone was OFY in Aug and DE Mario Ojemudia tore his Achilles after 5 sts. After allowing just 80.5 ypg (2.5) through the first 9, the unit was gashed for 307 vs Indy and 369 vs Ohio St after DT Glasgow was inj'd. TY they lose Ojemudia (19 tkl, 2 sk), Royce Jenkins-Stone (5 st, #8 tkl'r, 3 sk) and Willie Henry (10 st, 34 tkl, 6.5 sk, #4DC BAL). 2nd Tm B10 Chris Wormley was dominating inside (6.5 sk, 8 tfl) while Taco Charlton (PS#24) has started to play to his talent level (5.5 sk). With Glasgow and Mone back from injury and 2+ st's back along with PS#1 Rashan Gary, this is an improved unit.

LINEBACKERS - In '14 UM improved their ppg all'd to 22.4 (my computer called for 22.2 ppg, pg 43). LY they lost Jake Ryan (a1 tkl'r, 14 tfl, #4DC GB) but ret'd 7 of their top 8 (#2, #8 tkl'r) and got back Desmond Morgan (81 tkl '13, RS '14) so it was like having 3 st's back. My computer called for 19.8 ppg and they did even better at 16.4. TY the unit is the polar opposite. They lose Joe Bolden (12 st, #1 tkl'r, 6.5 tfl), Morgan (13 st, #2 tkl'r, 1 sk) and James Ross (4 st, #9 tkl'r, 5.5 tfl). The top returnee is Ben Gedeon (1 st, #11 tkl'r) but they get more athletic adding in S Jabrill Peppers (PS#1, inj '14).

DEFENSIVE BACKS - UM was just #81, #52 & #62 in my PDR in Hoke's final 3 years. LY they had 6 of their top 8 back and added Jabrill Peppers. I said, "UM should have their highest finish in my PDR s/07" and that they did at #3 (47.5%, 8-10). The star was CB Jourdan Lewis who set the schl record (Marlin Jackson, Leon Hall) with 22 pbu despite teams throwing away from him. TY they lose the QB of the unit in FS Jarrod Wilson (13 st, #3 tkl'r) & Wayne Lyons (6 tkl), while the explosive Peppers moves to LB full time. Three starters are back including their star and this is one of the B10's top secondaries.

SPECIAL TEAMS - UM was #66 in my ST rankings and had to replace all their top guys LY. Harbaugh's ST's at Stanford finished #27, #19, #2 and #40 in my rankings. New ST cch John Baxter had 9 Top 33 finishes in 16Y (USC, Fresno) and UM improved to #30. UM avg an amazing 28.4 on KR's with Jehu Chesson getting UM's 1st KR TD s/09 and 1st on an opening kickoff (vs NW) s/1992. Peppers avg 11.4 on PR's. Blake O'Neill had a solid year punting (41.3, 35.9 net) but is most known for his bobbled punt snap vs Mich St. Kenny Allen hit 18-22 FG (long 47). TY they lose their P and ST cch Baxter left to go back to USC, but they add in PS#1 P Quinn Nordin and the unit could be just as good.

COACHES - Jim Harbaugh ret'd to Ann Arbor where he was a B10 POY QB under his mentor Bo Schembechler in the mid '80's (#2 '86, #8 '87). He guaranteed a win over "Ohio" ('86) and delivered. From Schembechler in 1969 to Lloyd Carr going 20-6 his L2Y ('06-'07), Michigan had just 3 HC's in 39Y (Gary Moeller 44 W's '90-'94). Harbaugh's HC exp includes FCS San Diego (29-6), Stanford (29-21) and the NFL's 49ers (49-22-1). DC DJ Durkin took the HC job at Maryland. New DC Don Brown, AFCA '15 asst COY led BC's def to a 4th best ppg allowed in '15 (15.3). OC Tim Drevno was Harbaugh's OC at SD, TE/OL at Stanford & the OL at SF before spending '14 as USC's run gm coor. The ST/LB cch is Chris Partridge.

THIS DECADE 48-29 (62.3%) #38 - Heading into '08, UM had 40 str winning seasons (33 consec bowls), the NCAA's longest streaks. Lloyd Carr finished in the Top 25 in 12 out of

his 13 yrs. Carr's final game was a Capital One Bowl win over #9 Florida but in '08 I did not have Michigan ranked in my Top 50! UM had a rare losing year (3-9) and went 5-7 in '09 to finish that decade at 81-43 (65%). They went 7-6 in '10 then Rich Rod was axed after 3 yrs. Hoke wanted to run a pro-style attack but inherited spread personnel (Denard Robinson). UM had a season that went beyond everyone's expectations as they finished 11-2 in '11 (+130.8 ypg B10 play). They got a fortunate win in the Sugar Bowl (outFD'd 22-12) and finished #12 (3 str yrs NR prior). They had numerous factors pointing down in '12 and dropped to 8-5 and did not have a player drafted in the first 4 Rnds (1st time s/68). In '13 Mich was the preseason fav to win the Legends Div (I had them tied for 3rd). They got to 6-1 (#23) but finished 7-6 (4 of 6 losses by a comb 11 pts). In '14 UM had 15 ret st's but did have 4 tough AG's (19-2 at home under Hoke entering '14). UM's 16 year reign of leading the NCAA in avg attendance ended. They went just 5-7 and Hoke was let go. Another 1st year head coach had a great debut as Harbaugh led them to a 41-7 Citrus Bowl win and #12 in '15.

2015 ANALYSIS 10-3 - UM made a home run hire, bringing in Jim Harbaugh and most of the indicators were pointing up in '15. I had Michigan my #2 Most Improved team. Mich got a TD w/12-2 left to pull within 7 of a Utah team that got as high as #3 AP. A botched punt late 1H gave UM a gift TD w/14 left (17-7) and they beat Oreg St 35-7. Mich led UNLV 28-0 then amazingly shut out BYU, MD and #13 NW on B2B2B weeks. UM was outgained by Mich St 386-230 but still led 23-21 until a bobbled punt snap turned into a Spartan TD with :00 left! After a bye they needed a GL stand to hold off a Gopher tm the week after Jerry Kill resigned. UM waxed Rutgers but needed a TD w/00 left to force OT vs Indy and won in 2OT. They still had hopes of a B10 Title if they beat Ohio St (and Mich St lost) but Ohio St crushed them 42-13. UM routed the SEC East champs 41-7 in the bowl with a dominant 2H and finished #12.

PHIL'S FORECAST

OFFENSE - Michigan avg 31.4 ppg in '15, a large step up from the 20.9 of '14 and their best s/'11. 8 st's return on offense and the new QB should succeed with a unit that has 4 starting OL's and most of their top skill players back. My computer (pg 43) has them topping 35 ppg for just the 2nd time s/92.

DEFENSE - A lot of folks point to UM's defense as the reason for the turnaround but the '14 D was Top 10 (314 ypg) and they had 7 st's back. While DC Durkin is now HC at Maryland, Harbaugh made a great hire with BC's Don Brown and figures to remain 1 of the best.

2016 - In Brady Hoke's 1st year he took over a NR team and finished 11-2 (#12) and was ranked preseason Top 10 in year #2. Harbaugh took over a 5-7 tm, went 10-3 and finished #12 and has a pressn Top 10 team. Harbaugh inherited a better team and is more poised to keep the success rolling. They do have a Stock Market Indicator of -4.0. Michigan has 14 ret st's and is stronger at RB, REC, OL, DL and DB with each of those units at or near the top of the Big Ten. They trade Utah and BYU for Colorado and Hawaii in the non-conf schedule. While they face both Iowa and Mich St on the road, they could be favored in their first 11 games. Eight of my 9 sets of power ratings call for a DD win season and this team is a national title contender but must travel to Columbus for "The Game" Nov 26th.

Michigan is 2-0 (both prior mtg's on the island). UM won the L/gm 48-17 in '98 which was played after rival OSU (only 2nd time s/43 UM didn't end reg ssn vs OSU). UM is 23-3 in home openers.

First mtg. Into '16, Wolverines are 21-1 the L7Y at the Big House vs non-conf opp's (loss was in '14 vs Utah 26-10). TY marks 1st time s/05 UM will play only 3 reg ssn non-conf foes, B10 now 9 gm slate.

Wolverines are 3-1 incl a 27-3 win in the L/mtg ('97). UM came in ranked #14 while CU was #8 but tms ssn's went in opposite directions. UM finished 12-0 (#1) w/ a Nat'l Title while CU went just 5-6.

UM had dropped 4 str from '08-'13 but has won each of the L2Y. LY after PSU trimmed the lead to 21-16 w/8:05 left UM went 40/5pl for a td (after 55 yd KR) & ran out L/4:00 after forcing a SOD.

The home tm is 6-1 since '02. In the L/mtg ('10) the Wolverines ran into the #6 Badgers and trailed 24-0 at HT on their way to a 48-28 loss. The last 4Y Michigan is 4-11 vs ranked foes but went 3-2 L.Y.

LTH (inaugural mtg) the gm had 6 lead changes. UM cut the deficit to 2 w/9:17 left and got the ball back w/6:34. After a 48/9pl drive the Wolverines tried a 56 yd fg but it was blk'd (RU ran out L/3:01).
