

QUARTERBACKS - Eli Manning set or tied 47 UM records before he departed after the '03 ssn (#1DC NYG, 2 Super Bowl wins). Over the next 8Y, UM QB's comb to hit between 48-56% each ssn. In '12 Bo Wallace (NJCAA single ssn rec pass yds, 4604 and TD passes w/53) won the st'g job and over his 3 yrs in Oxford, accumulated 9,534 (63%, 62-41). He finished #2 on the Rebels car list behind Manning in both yds & td's. In '14 DeVante Kincade (PS#43) and 6'3" Ryan Buchanan were the bkps. They added Chad Kelly (PS#12 orig Clemson) who led his team to the NJCAA Nat'l Title (3906, 47 td's). Despite the loss of a 3Y st'r I did not expect a drastic drop. After 3 yrs of Good Bo, Bad Bo, Kelly was more consistent and threw for 4,042 (65.1%, 31-13, 500 rush). The bkps comb'd for 17-28-175 and both transferred. Kelly (NFL HOF'r Jim's nephew) is one of the top QB's in the country and has a pair of new VHT (PS#2, #35) backups.

RUNNING BACKS - This unit is usually loaded with VHT's but none have stepped up and taken charge. In '13 l'Tavius Mathers (PS#30) led w/563 (5.9) while Jaylen Walton (PS#41) had 523 (4.6). In '14 Mathers slipped to 290 (4.3). The diminutive Walton (5'8" 172) led w/586 (5.5) basically adding a yd to his ypc with a 91 yd td run. RFr Jordan Wilkins (PS#29) had 10-171 vs Presb (#2, 361, 6.9), Mathers trans LY but they added in PS#30JC Akeem Judd & PS#19 true frosh Eric Swinney. Walton had 133 vs Vandy but was banged up and had just 62 the next 3 gms. He led with 730 (5.1) and QB Kelly was #2. Judd had 68 vs A&M and was #3 (421, 5.5) while Wilkins was #4 w/379 (5.3). They lose Walton but could top LY's overall production.

RECEIVERS - In '13 true frosh Laquon Treadwell (6'2' PS#2) became UM's 1st ever SEC Frosh POY as he led the team in rec's (72) but was a distant #2 in yds (608, 8.4). In '14 they had to replace their #1 Donté Moncrief (#3DC) and #3WR's (comb 1521, 14.8). Cody Core (5 rec '12-13) had 195 yds in the first 2 (#4 w/558, 13.6). Treadwell was #1 (632, 13.2) prior to breaking his leg vs Auburn. TE Engram finished #2 (1st Tm SEC, 662, 17.4). LY they lost their #1 (696, 17.8) but also added in PS#8 & #16 true frosh. Treadwell had six 100 yard gms and led with 1,153 (14.1) while 6'3" Quincy Adeboyejo (PS#84) was #3 (604, 15.9). Soph Damore'ea Stringfellow (PS#13) had 503 (14.0). This year they lose 3rd Tm AA Treadwell (11 st, #1DC MIN) and #2 Core (9 st, 644, 17.4, #6DC CIN). With 4 of the top 6 back and the addition of 4 VHT's, this unit will be close

to 15 despite the departure of their top 2. **OFFENSIVE LINE** - This unit was a ? in 14 with just 2 st'rs back (55 car sts). The rush ypg dropped to 155 (4.2, 31 sk). Everyone from the 2 deep ret'd LY (112 car st) but unfortunately they had 27 starts lost to injury or susp in the group. Laremy Tunsil had to sit out the first 7 and when he ret'd the line was

much stronger with Fahn Cooper being able to move back to his preferred RT spot. C Robert Conyers was OFY after 5 sts. The Rebels still improved to 183 ypg rush (5.1, 19 sk). TY they lose LT Tunsil (6/26, #1DC MIA), Cooper (13/39, #5DC SF), RG Justin Bell (5/31), LG Aaron Morris (9/40) and C Ben Still (8/20). They do return 6 with starting exp (36 car st) with 10 VHT's and add in PS#1 Greg Little. They should remain healthier and be a solid unit despite dropping to 36 car sts.

DEFENSIVE LINE-LY the Rebels had to replace 4 DL (18 st, 103 tkl, 8 sk) as CJ Johnson moved to MLB. They had 3 ret st'rs (4 of top 5 DL tkl'rs) incl Robert Nkemdiche. They added in PS#4JC DJ Jones. NT Issac Gross was OFY in the opener and Nkemdiche missed 4 sts. The numbers improved slightly to 127 (3.3, 29 sk). TY they lose 2nd Tm AA Nkemdiche (11 st, 29 tkl, 7 tfl, #1DC ARZ), DE Channing Ward (4 st, 35 tkl, 6.5 tfl, UFA TB) and DT Woodrow Hamilton (12 st, 29 tkl, 1 sk, UFA NE). Gross (114 car tkl, 7 sk) returns as does DE Fadol Brown (turn down NFL) and 2nd Tm SEC Marquis Haynes (43 tkl, 10 sk). Despite the loss of their star, they should be just as strong.

LINEBACKERS - In '13 HC Hugh Freeze recruited PS#4 Tony Conner for the Husky pos and he was the #3 tkl'r. In '14 they only had to replace their #5 tkl'r (12 st). I had the Rebels rated as my #3 LB corps. During the reg ssn they gave up just 13.8 ppg and the 3-man unit had 4 of the team's top 7 tkl'rs. LY they lost their #3, #4 & #7 tkl'rs but CJ Johnson (PS#11) moved in from the DL. Injuries hurt the unit as Johnson and Denzel Nkemdiche each missed 4 sts while Conner missed 8. Ole Miss allowed 386 ypg (highest under Freeze) and the ppg went from 16.0 in '14 to 22.6 LY. This year they lose Nkemdiche (9 st, #4 tkl'r, 6.5 tfl), CJ Johnson (9 st, #5 tkl'r, 2 sk, UFA NE) and Christian Russell (1 st, #10 tkl'r, 4.5 tfl). Soph DeMarquis Gates (PS#29) only st'd 4 but was the #1 tkl'r. With a healthy Conner back and the addition of Oregon St's #1 tkl'r Rommel Mageo and former Georgia LB Detric Bing-Dukes, this unit could be stronger with 6 of the top 9 back.

DEFENSIVE BACKS - In '10 the Rebels had to replace 3 st'rs and plummeted to #104 (61%, 24-6) in my PDR. The unit improved 4 straight yrs (#77, #61, #51, #15). In '14 they had 2 DB's make the 15 semis for the Thorpe Award in CB Senguez Golson (#2DC PIT) and FS Cody Prewitt while all'g just 12 td passes. LY they had to replace both. Freeze signed 6'0" PS#6JC Tony Bridges. They ret'd their #1 and #6 tkl'rs but slipped to #45 (59.8% 23-15). TY they lose 2nd Tm AA S Trae Elston (13 st, #2 tkl', 4 int, 14 pbu, UFA NO), 2nd Tm SEC S Mike Hilton (11 st, #3 tkl'r, 11 tfl, 13 pbu, 2 int, UFA JAX), and S Chief Brown (2 st, 26 tkl, 3 pbu). They again have 2 st'rs back (#7 & #9 tkl'rs) but should move up in my PDR.

SPECIAL TEAMS - In '14 I said this unit figured to drop a few notches losing their P, K & PR and they did, down to #80. All 3 kicking positions had split duties. True frosh Gary Wunderlich (PS#6) avg 45.2 on 10 punts, had 13 TB on 35 KO and was their long fg man (6-8, L47, 2 miss 50+). Will Gleeson was the top P (42.9, tm net 41.7!). The return game was avg in 14 and again in '15 (3.7 PR, 17.7 KR). Nathan Noble had 54 tb on 94 KO's. Gleeson avg 40.7 (tm net 39.3) and Wunderlich (63-63 PAT) hit 19-25 FG (long 48). They moved up to #71 and could make a large climb if they get some production out of the return game.

COACHES - MS native Hugh Freeze starts vr #5 as HC in Oxford on a roll! He took over a 2-10 Rebels squad in '12 and has led them to 7.8.9 & 10 wins his first 4Y, including the 43-37 win over then #2 'Bama in Tuscaloosa last Sept. He is the first coach in Ole Miss history to get to bowls in each of his first 4 yrs. In '11, he became just the 14th FBS HC to win 10 games his first yr as HC (Ark St). Also back for a 5th year are co-OC's and Ole Miss alum Matt Luke (Duke's OC 4Y) and Dan Werner (QB cch for 4 Nat'l Title teams at Miami) The fifth yr DC is 35 yr vet Dave Wommack who has been a DC at 7 diff schools incl Ark St ('11) Ga Tech ('08-'09) and Ark ('02-'04). Jason Jones was hired as a co-DC in '13 (5Y Okla St). Corey Batoon is in his 2nd year as ST cch

THIS DECADE 40-36 (52.6%) #67 - From 1954-1971, the Rebels went to 17 bowls (12 NY's Day). From '05-'11 they had only 2 winning ssns finishing 9-4 (#14) in '08 and 9-4 (#20) in '09. (63-58 from '00-'09). After B2B losing years to open this decade they let go of Houston Nutt. In '12 I pointed out that my Stock Market Indicator was

+4.5 and they had 16 st'rs back for new HC Freeze who clearly got the most out of his '11 Ark St and '12 Ole Miss squads. Freeze even admitted mid '12 that he was not really expecting Miss to get to a bowl. In '13 they avoided the big 3 out of the East and had 19 ret st'rs. Freeze pointed out they were fortunate with injuries in '12. The '13 ssn was a diff story as their D was banged up which resulted in improving to just 8-5. In 2014 Ole Miss had 15 ret st'rs (#18 AP pressn). They got to #3 in the country at 7-0 but lost 3 of the next 4 (inj plagued). They were hammered 42-3 by #6 TCU in the Peach Bowl to finish 9-4 and #17. LY they got to #3 again and after a bowl blowout win

finished #10. They are 40-36 this decade. **2015 ANALYSIS 10-3** - Ole Miss had 16 ret st'rs and avoided Georgia, Tenn and Missouri out of the East, Four of my 9 sets of power ratings called for their first DD win season in 12 vears. Ole Miss scored 76 & 73 their first two games then dealt eventual Nat'l Champ Alabama their only loss of the season. They rose to #3 but were upset in The Swamp by Florida 38-10. Two weeks later they were up 14-0 but got ambushed in Memphis 37-24. After wins vs A&M and Auburn, Ark got a 4&25 backwards lateral FD and rallied to beat the Rebels in OT 58-52. Had that play not happened, Ole Miss would have been in the SEC Title game as they beat LSU and Miss St by DD's. They were better prepared for their NY's 6 bowl and whipped Oklá St 48-20 to finish 10-3 and #10 with the most impressive regular season win of any team in the country.

OFFENSE - There were questions at QB heading into last year but Chad Kelly answered them tenfold. The school lists just 3 ret st'rs but the OL coming back comb'd to start 26 gms LY so I have 2 OL ret st'rs (schl 0) and 5 st'rs back. I do not see them putting up 149 pts their first two games so they will have a tough time matching '15's 40.8 ppg but are potent

DEFENSE - The Rebels lose 4 of their top 5 tkl'rs and only

return 5 st'rs although DeMarquis Gates was the #1 tkl'r despite not being a full-time starter. The Land Shark defense will be tough again and could lower the ppg allowed.

2016 - Ole Miss is still the only original SEC West team without a trip to the SEC Title game. Their last SEC Title was in 1963. They do go from being the #43 most exp'd team to just #106 but have QB Chad Kelley back and Freeze continues to bring in top notch recruiting classes. They did have an Off YPP of 12.7 (pg 25) and are -28 All conf Pts (pg 33). Ole Miss was one wacky lateral play vs Arkansas from getting to the SEC title gm LY and have gone from 8 to 9 to 10 wins. The Rebels are one of the most talented teams in the country and showed last year they could win on the road when they knocked off Bama. This team is capable of contending for the SEC title but I will call for their streak of improving their win total to stop this year.
