
## SAN DIEGO STATE AZTEGS



In 2014 the Aztecs threw for just 2,319 (52%, 10-15) and had to replace both QB's heading into 2015. Kentucky transfer Maxwell Smith (11 st '11-'13) battled rFr Christian Chapman for the starting job. Smith had trouble connecting on mid-range passes and the Aztecs dropped 3 straight non-conf games. In MW action, Smith was a game manager, going 8 games without an interception (school rec) but never attempted more than 19 passes in a game. Smith tore his ACL during that span, prior to the MW Title game and Chapman led the Aztecs to the victory and then to the Hawai'i Bowl win. Smith passed for 1,529 (55%, 13-2). Chapman threw for 436 (59.2%, 2-1, 72 rush). This year they lose Smith (12 st, denied 6th yr) but Chapman is a more dangerous runner and proved he can manage this offense as well.

NINITING BACKS - Adam Muema topped 1,000 yds in both '12 & '13 while Donnel Pumphrey had 3 consecutive 100 yd games and was #2 (752, 6.0, #5 rec) in '13. HC Rocky Long did not think Pumphrey had the size (5'9" 180) to be the feature back but he proved otherwise. Pumphrey had 21-261 vs SJSt (sat out final 21 min). Pumphrey topped George Jones' 95 single season record w/1,867 (6.8) although I was surprised that Marshall Faulk didn't hold that record (1630, '92). Chase Price was #2 w/674 (4.8). Last year Pumphrey got off to a slow start (3 sub 100 in F/4) then rattled off 8 straight 100 yard games (1653, 5.4) and was also #1 in rec's (28-416, 14.9). Price went over 100 on 3 occasions (1008, 5.3, 118 rec) and they became the first Aztec duo to both top 1,000. Rashaad Penny was #3 (368, 6.0). Pumphrey returns and said he wants to be known as the best RB to ever come out of SDSt & break every record. They lose Price and versatile FB Dakota Gordon (14 st, 187) 5.1). Rashaad Penny (PS#81), Marcus Stamps (PS#81), Juwan Washington (PS#129, 111 in SG) and true frosh Chase Jasmin (PS#85) will battle to be the #2 guy and the Aztecs won't lose

a step as long as Pumphrey stays healthy.

13 14 Eric Judge (218, 16.8, '13) led w/471 (19.6). Last year they returned 4 of their top 6. Soph Mikah Holder finished #1 w/just 439 (18.3). Judge was #3 w/296 (19.7) while Jemond Hazely (only Sr in unit) added 263 (12.5). This year the group only loses Hazely (3 st) and I would expect the top 3 to surpass their totals (998, 16.6) of a year ago.

ME LINE - In 2014 the Aztecs had 3 returning starters (57 car sts ret) but made changes to the lineup and went with their 5 most physical OL's and improved to 216 ypg (5.4, 23 sk). Last year they lost a 2nd Tm MW 2Y LT and 2 C's (13 st). They had 55 car sts back. RG Darrell Greene (most physical

OL) was susp the first 6 & they avg just 180.3 rush ypg (4.0) but with him back they had 282 (5.5) over the next 7 (susp bowl, 233). TY they lose 1st Tm MW RT Pearce Slater (14/27), RG Greene (7/32), and RG Robert Craighead (7/10). They return 56 car sts which includes 1st Tm MW LG Nico Siragusa. This unit is quite comparable to '15's top notch group.

**DEFENSIVE LINE** - HC Rocky Long usually fielded undersized, inexp'd D-lines at New Mexico (HC there '98-'08) yet every year had a solid rush D. It looks like he's recaptured that magic here (see '14 mag). Long values speed over size but puts his biggest players at NT. Last year they had to replace just starter and I called for it to be Long's best D-line here. They held 9 of their opp's to 80 rush yards or less. The Aztecs allowed just 109 ypg (3.2, 37 sk), easily the best of Long's tenure. The group was led by 1st Tm MW DE Alex Barrett. This year they must replace 3rd Tm MW DT Christian Heyward (9 st. 31 tkl. 5.5 tfl) and 3rd Tm MW DE Jon Sanchez (14 st. 38 tkl. 5.5 sk. 2.5 tfl). They do get Barrett back and Kyle Kelley had 3.5 sks in their bowl. Despite the losses this is still a strong unit.

LETTES - At New Mexico, Long's LOBO was technically a S but basically a LB (remember Brian Urlacher?), so I list the AZTEC position in the LB write-up. In '14, the Aztecs looked to rebound from an injury plagued '13 (31.7 ppg, highest in 5Y). They had to replace their #1, #3 and #6 tkl'rs. They ret'd 3 who had been full time st'rs but Jake Fely RS. They improved to allowing 19.8 ppg. Last year they lost their #1, #8, and #10 tkl'rs. Fely finally stayed relatively healthy. Calvin Munson finished #1 in tkls (98) and sks (9.5, 7 qbh), earning 3rd Tm AA & 1st Tm MW.This year's only loss is Fely (12 st, 2nd Tm MW, #3 tkl'r, 8.5 tfl). They get the #1, #2, & #9 tkl'rs back so are more exp'd and the MW's best.

FINSIME BAPES - In Long's schemes, the S positions are called Warriors. In '14 the Aztecs had just 1 starter back but by the end of the year, Long felt he had the top 2 CB's (both 2nd Tm MW) in JJ Whittaker (#3 tkl'r, 8 pd) and Demontae Kazee (14 pd). SDSt moved up to #36 in my PDR (55.8%, 10-14). Last year I called for this to be the top secondary in the MW. Kazee tied SDSt's schl rec w/8 int's (MW DPOY, 4th Tm AA). The new Warrior's finished #3 and #7 tkl'rs. Despite starter Trey Lomax being OFY after 1 gm (9 tkl), they moved up to #14 (53.5%, 14-23). This year they lose Whittaker (2x 2nd Tm MW, 3Y st'r, #8 tkl'r) and Pierre Romain (18 tkl). Kazee originally announced he was leaving for the NFL but decided to return. They are the best in the MW again but may not match that #14 finish unless another super CB emerges.

BYLTEWNS-Last year the unit had to replace their P & KO guy. P Tanner Blain avg'd 40.3 (37.0 net). KR Rashaad Penny was the MW ST's POY after he scored 3 td and had an exceptional 33.5 avg. PR Lloyd Mills avg'd 9.5 and Damontae Kazee had a td (14.0). They continued to climb finishing #16 in my STR. This year they lose K Donald Hageman (17-22, L54, 24 TB/86 KO). They also have a huge loss in LS Jeff Overbaugh (UFA LA) who was a perfect 510/510 on his career snaps. Long has had trouble finding trustworthy K's in the past but the rest of the unit is among the best in the country.

overdue. From 1921-2010 (90Y) San Diego St only went to 9 bowls (only once B2B). In Rocky Long's 5 seasons as HC (DC here prev 3) he has taken them to 5 straight and was LY's MW COY leading the Aztecs to their first 11 win season since 1969 when Don Coryell was HC. He previously was HC at New Mexico ('98-'08) where he took the Lobos to bowls in 5 of his L7Y. Long called his own defensive plays at New Mexico and has done the same here. Jeff Horton is in his 6th season

here (RB cch) and 2nd as OC. He was also a HC at UNLV from '94-'98 and at Nevada in '93. ST cch Bobby Hauck was formerly HC at UNLV ('10-'14) as well at Montana ('03-'09, playoffs al 7 years, 3 Title games).

ingly San Diego St did not have a winning season 15 Tm Net Avg from '99-'09 (38-80) and was just 27-48 in MW play from '00-'09. In '10 despite being 6-18 (-130 ypg) in the MW ('07-'09), the Aztecs made my Most Improved List (#6) and had their first winning ssn s/98 (12 yrs!). Now they have had 6 straight 000\$1, (25.7)...#36 winning seasons (36-12 in MW play). In 2014 with just 10 ret st'rs their record dropped to 7 wins (9

in 12, 8 in 13). Last year they were my pick to be in the MW Title game and they went 11-3. Their 52-27 record this decade is Top 25 but they were never ranked in that span.

**20 5 ANALYSIS 11-3** - In 2015, I said they were capable of their first double digit win season s/1971 and the Aztecs delivered. Things did not look great early as they lost to Cal by 28, were upset at home by South Alabama in OT and then lost at Penn St by 16. They were -175 ypg vs those 3 FBS foes. Rocky Long must use the non-conf as preseason games as they were dominant in the MW (+176 ypg, +22.5 ppg) and delivered for me week after week in my Inside the ressbox newsletter. It was the first time in their 93 year history they went 8-0 in league play (closest gm 14 pts). In the MW Title game they were down to #3 QB Chapman and needed a FG with 5:10 left to beat Air Force. Chapman benefitted from bowl practices and in his 2nd start they destroyed Cincy (led 42-0, Cincy TD 3:21 left) to finish 11-3

## PHIL'S FOREBAST

OFFENSE - RB Donnel Pumphrey opted to return for his senior season and that is huge for this RB driven team. They do lose their outstanding FB Dakota Gordan and #2 rusher Chase Price. The Aztecs actually went from 394 ypg to 375 in '15 but thire ppg increased by over a TD (25.0 to 32.1). With 7 starters back they will improve on the ypg and possibly the ppg

DEFENSE - Rocky Long's 3-3-5 is a tough D to prepare for and does not need huge DL's. It relies on speed and camouflage as the blitzes come from everywhere. Last year with 8 starters back they had his best D here allowing just 16.4 ppg (#10 FBS) and 287 ypg (#5). This year they have 7 starters (6 of top 7 tkl'rs) back including all three 1st Team MW players. They could be even stronger but it will be tough to top last year's numbers.

2016 - Last year the Aztecs were picked by the media to win their division for the first time since they joined the MW 17 years ago. They had accumulated 22 first place votes over the first 16 years but had 27 last year. They enter 2016 with a 10 game win streak which ties for the longest in school history. Their 11 wins in '15 tied a school record (1966 & 1969 both 11-0) but they only finished #29 AP. In 8 of the L10 years they have finished higher than picked in the MW media poll and did not last year due to being picked first. They were +22 in my Turnovers=Turnaround (pg 30) and also have other signs that point down. Pointing up is their talent level with most of the key players back from the MW's #1 team (+175.8 ypg). They avoid Air Force & Boise St out of the Mountain. Four of my 9 sets of power ratings (including 1 of my main 2) call for an unbeaten season and they could be favored in every regular season game this year.
