Secondary Woes
Kansas State had their way through the air on Saturday. The Wildcats took advantage of a banged Roadrunner secondary seemingly in every big moment of the game. UTSA gave up 285 yards through the air but it felt like much more.

No Pressure on the QB
While there a lot of attention will be paid to the secondary and pass defense, UTSA lost the battle in the trenches. The Roadrunners were unable to get any pressure on K-State's QB. On the flip side, the Wildcats d-line was stout. K-State limited UTSA's run game while putting pressure in the pocket.

10 Points in 43 Seconds
Kansas State stunned UTSA with 10 straight points in the last 43 seconds of the first half. The Roadrunners trailed by only 10 points at this point of the game. But a 42 yard field followed, then a DJ Gillins fumble, and then a 33 yard TD pass, and just like that, K-State led big at the half. It was the turning point of the game.

Pedestrian Offensive Effort
UTSA showed much offensive improvement from week one to week two. We didn't see that this week. The Roadrunners had a few good drives but could never really get anything consistently going.

Near Must-Win vs Texas State
After three humbling losses to begin this 2018 season, UTSA is now put in a near must-win situation against Texas State next week. If the Roadrunners are hoping to salvage any kind of positivity for the rest of the season, they need a win sooner rather than later.
