TEAM

- » 44 different players have made a start this season, including 15 who have gotten the first starts of their career after Jackson LaDuke got the nod at inside linebacker.
- » Oregon used its 12th different starting combination on defense this season.
- » Scored on the opening drive of the second half for the seventh time this season.
- » Held 11 of 13 opponents under their current season rushing average.
- » Now has 17 interceptions on the season and 23 total takeaways.
- » Recorded multiple INTs in a game for the fifth time this year and the 19th time since 2018 most among Power 5 teams in that span.

#1 LB NOAH SEWELL

- » Led Oregon with 12 tackles (eight solo) while adding an interception, forced fumble, and tackle for loss.
- » Became the first Oregon player to reach the 100-tackle mark in a season since Troy Dye.
- » Came away with first career INT, picking off a pass on the first play of the second quarter.
- » Forced a fumble for the second time this season and third in his career.
- » Third UO player since 2000 and first since 2014 to record double-digit tackles, an INT and forced fumble in a game.
- » His 12 tackles matches the most by an Oregon player in a Pac-12 Championship Game.

#5 DE KAYVON THIBODEAUX

- » Finished with three tackles and a sack.
- » Now has 4.5 sacks, 5.5 TFLs and 13 tackles in three career Pac-12 Championship Games.
- » Recorded his 19th career sack to move into a tie for seventh all-time at Oregon.
- » 35.5 career TFLs, 0.5 away from cracking the UO all-time top 10.

#13 QB ANTHONY BROWN

- » Completed 13-of-24 passes for 147 yards.
- » Has now completed a pass to 18 different receivers this season after connecting with Isaah Crocker three times for 51 yards.

#23 S VERONE MCKINLEY III

- » Picked off sixth pass of the season on a second quarter INT, taking over sole possession of the FBS lead.
- » Now has 11 career interceptions, one away from moving into the UO career top 10.
- » One interception away from breaking into the UO single-season top 10.

#26 RB TRAVIS DYE

- » Led Oregon with 82 rushing yards and a touchdown on 15 carries while also leading the team with four catches for 27 yards.
- » Moved from 21st to 18th on the Oregon single-season rushing list, raising his 2021 total to 1,118 yards.
- » Now fifth on the school's career rushing list with 2,958 yards, passing Jonathan Stewart (2,891) and teammate CJ Verdell (2,929).
- » Tied for eighth in school history in single season rushing TDs with 15.
- » Found the end zone on the ground for the 20th time in his career and has 28 total TDs.
- » Moved into the UO career top 10 for all-purpose yards, now sitting in 10th with 4,156 yards, passing Keenan Howry (4,114).
- » 42 rushing yards away from becoming the fifth player in program history to reach 3,000 in a career.

#88 WR ISAAH CROCKER

- » Set career-highs with three receptions for 52 yards, including a career-long 33-yard reception in the fourth quarter.
- » Came into the game with just one career reception for 16 yards.

General—Pac-12 Championship

- Making its third appearance in the conference title game (2018, '19, '21), Utah won its first Pac-12 Championship in program history. The Utes joined the conference in 2011.
- All-time, Utah has won 27 conference championships in football, including as members of the Pac-12 (1), Mountain West (4), WAC (2), Skyline Conference (5), Big Seven (5) and Rocky Mountain Conference (10). It is the first conference title for the Utes since winning the 2008 Mountain West crown.
- Since being named head coach in 2005, head coach <u>Kyle Whittingham</u> has led Utah to two conference championships (2008 Mountain West, 2021 Pac-12).
- Utah delivered Oregon its first loss when playing in the Pac-12 Championship Game. The Ducks had been 4-0 since the conference added the championship game in 2011.
- Senior safety <u>Brandon McKinney</u> (Utah 2021, Washington 2018) became the first player to appear with multiple teams in the Pac-12 Championship Game. Since 1996, there are only two other known players to have appeared in a conference championship for two different teams, both in the SEC:
 - Nick Marshall (Georgia '11, Auburn '13)
 - Brenton Cox Jr. (Georgia '18, Florida '20)
- Utah's 14-0 lead at the end of the first quarter matches the largest for a Pac-12 Football Championship Game and most since the first held championship game in 2011. Oregon led UCLA 21-7 in the first such game in 2011.
- Junior LB <u>Devin Lloyd</u> was named the game's MVP (7 tackles, 5 solo, 1 INT-TD)

General—Game

- Utah won its 10th game of the season. Under Whittingham, the Utes have six 10-win seasons (2008, '09, '10, '15, '19, '21).
- Dating back to 2020, Utah has won four straight games over AP-ranked opponents. The Utes last had four straight AP-ranked wins in a span from 1994-96.
- For the first time in recorded program history, Utah has won multiple games in the same season over top-10 AP-ranked teams.
- Utah now has three wins this season vs. top-25 AP-ranked teams (No. 18 Arizona State, No. 4 Oregon, No. 10 Oregon). The Utes last had three such wins in the 2008 campaign.
- Utah has won back-to-back games vs. Oregon for the first time since taking the 1991 and '94 matchups between the teams.
- Whittingham, the winningest leader in Utah football history, improved to 144-69 as head coach (2005-present).
 Including his time as an assistant (1994-2004), Whittingham has been part of 228 Utes victories, more than any other coach in program history.
- Utah has now held the lead at halftime in 10 of 13 games this season. Two of the Utes' three largest leads at the break this season have come vs. Oregon:

- Nov. 5 at Stanford: Utah 38, Stanford 0 (38 points)
- Nov. 20 vs. Oregon: Utah 28, Oregon 0 (28 points)
- Dec. 3 vs. Oregon: Utah 23, Oregon 0 (23 points)
- Between the regular season (1-for-6) and championship (0-for-5) matchups with Utah, Oregon was held to a
 combined 1-for-11 during the first half on third-down conversions and was outscored a combined 51-0 in that
 time. Oregon entered the Pac-12 Championship Game ranked No. 3 in FBS in third-down conversions
 (52.9%).
- Utah did not surrender a third-down conversion to Oregon until late in the third quarter, on the Ducks' eighth attempt.
- Oregon won the coin toss and deferred to the second half. Utah defended the South goal to begin the game.
- Utah was joined on-field for the coin toss by honorary captain **Donna Lowe**, mother of the late *Aaron Lowe*.

Offense

- Sophomore quarterback <u>Cameron Rising</u> passed for a touchdown (11 yards to <u>Dalton Kincaid</u>) during the second quarter. Rising has passed for at least one score in three of Utah's last four games.
- Kincaid's touchdown reception was his team-leading seventh of the season. Kincaid is the first Utah tight end with seven receiving touchdowns in a season since at least 1996.
- Junior wide receiver <u>Britain Covey</u> had eight receptions in the game and now has 184 catches in his career as a Ute. Covey moved into No. 2 on the Utah career receptions list with the performance, passing Bryan Rowley (177 from 1989-93).
- Covey's 184 career receptions also leads all active players in the Pac-12.
- Covey has now caught at least one pass in 16 straight games and 43 of his 46 career games as a Ute.
- Sophomore running back <u>Tavion Thomas</u> crossed the 1,000-yard rushing mark for the season late in the second quarter. He now has 1,041 yards on 186 carries (5.6).
- Thomas added another three-yard touchdown in the fourth quarter. It brings his season total to 20, extending his school single-season record.
- Thomas is the seventh player to rush for multiple touchdowns in Pac-12 Championship history and first since Oregon's CJ Verdell in 2019.
- Through Friday's game, Thomas has scored 14 of Utah's last 22 rushing touchdowns.
- Junior and fellow running back <u>TJ Pledger</u> had a four-yard scamper to the end zone in the third quarter, marking the first Pac-12 Championship Game that multiple Utes have rushed for a touchdown.
- Pledger's third quarter score was his sixth of the season, marking the first season since 2010 that Utah has had two running backs produce six or more rushing touchdowns.
- Utah scored on its game-opening drive for the seventh time this season (6 TD, 1 FG) and first time since the Arizona game (Nov. 13).

Defense

- Both of Oregon's two lowest total offensive outputs this season have come against Utah. It includes a 221yard performance Friday night in the Pac-12 Championship, and 294 yards in the teams' Nov. 20 meeting in Salt Lake City.
- Junior linebacker <u>Devin Lloyd</u> had a 34-yard pick-six during the first quarter. It was Lloyd's second pick-six of the season (at Stanford) and third of his career.
- In three career games vs. Oregon, including two Pac-12 Championships, Lloyd averaged 7.3 tackles per contest with a high of nine stops in the 2019 title game. Totaled, Lloyd also had 2.0 TFL against the Ducks, one sack, and Friday's interception return touchdown.
- Lloyd's pick-six was the first by a Ute during a Pac-12 Championship Game, and first by any player in a Pac-12 Championship Game since 2018. Including Lloyd, there have now been four interceptions returned four touchdowns during the Pac-12 Championship Game all-time.
- As a team, Utah has now returned three interceptions for touchdowns this season, the first time since 2019
 (four) that the Utes have accomplished this feat.
- Freshman safety <u>Cole Bishop</u> led the Utes with a game-high eight tackles (one sack), adding a pass breakup
 on the play immediately following the sack.
- Bishop now has 3.0 sacks on the season and 8.0 TFL, all in the last five games (since Stanford on Nov. 5).
- Bishop added a pass breakup on the next play after the sack, his fifth of the season--again all since the Stanford game.

- Sophomore linebacker <u>Malone Mataele</u> picked off Oregon quarterback Anthony Brown late in the second quarter for Mataele's first career interception.
- Freshman defensive tackle <u>Tennessee Pututau</u> recorded his first career sack during the third quarter.
- For the eighth time this season and second straight time vs. Oregon, Utah held its opponent scoreless on its game-opening drive.
- Oregon did not cross into Utah territory until the second quarter and was limited to 26 yards of total offense during the first quarter.

Special Teams

- Sophomore punter <u>Michael Williams</u> reset his career-long for the second straight game, and twice within Friday's game. Williams' first punt went for 53 yards during the first quarter, and he followed that with a 54-yarder in the third quarter. Both landed inside the Oregon 15-yard line.
- Williams had entered with a previous career-long punt of 50 yards during the Colorado game on Nov. 26.
- Sophomore <u>Jadon Redding</u> drilled a career-long 50-yard field goal as time expired on the first half.
- Since the Pac-12 Championship game began in 2011, only Redding and former Ute <u>Matt Gay</u> (53 in 2018) have made field goals of 50-plus yards in a Pac-12 Championship Game.
- Utah has produced points via special teams to end the first half in both of its 2021 matchups with Oregon. It
 includes Redding's field goal this evening as well as a 78-yard punt return touchdown by <u>Britain Covey</u> on
 Nov. 20 at Rice-Eccles Stadium.

Opening Statement

"Good evening, appreciate you guys waiting around. Certainly not the result we wanted. We felt good coming in, had a good week of practice and preparation. We had a really big goal trying to win our third (Pac-12 Championship) in a row but credit to them they earned the victory tonight. We found ourselves in third down situations and couldn't convert them. And certainly the big turnover early with the interception for a touchdown, and we couldn't capitalize on turnovers that we forced on them. We got down there and had a field goal miss and then went three-and-out after the other turnover."

On reports of his future...

"I don't know what you mean when you say someone's offered (a job). I haven't talked to anybody. Let's not create narratives. As we sit here in this press conference, Oregon is working on some stuff for me and that's what I have right now. That's the extent of the conversation."

On uncertainty surrounding his future...

"I would say if there's something to report, I will report it. I always have. Over the years, because certain things are put out there or not. Every year our entire staff, whether behind the scenes, whether public or not, we've always had different people come for our people, including myself, and how the media treats it and how they choose to posture it, I have no control. As I just mentioned, that's the extent of it."

On if players were distracted by rumors...

"I don't know what to tell you. I can tell you this, if I had any plans, if I had a decision to make or if I had something to report I would and I wouldn't keep it one way or the other. OK? Do I expected people to come at me? Yeah, I do. It happens every single year. Is there anything else to report besides that? There's nothing else to report besides that. When there ever is, if there ever is, I'll make sure to get it to you as fast as I can."

On if he would listen to another job offer...

"I'm not going to get into hypotheticals. We just finished off and we played and coached very poorly and I think you understand I have a job to do. I feel like we're going in circles with the same answers. You're going to get the same response."

On if he thought about changing quarterbacks...

"We're playing well as an offense. We went in there thinking a certain game plan would give us the best chance and that's what we went with. So we stuck with that decision."

On if his outlook changes on the trajectory of Oregon's program...

"No, it's certainly disappointing. I'm disappointed in ourselves as a staff, as a team. We found a way to win 10 games despite a lot of injuries. We had some really bright moments. We got one of the best road victories in the country this year. Then we had a couple of disappointing losses, but to have 10 wins on the season and then win the North Division and give ourselves an opportunity to win our third straight Pac-12 Championship. We didn't get it done, but the other team earned it, so congratulations."

On where he goes before signing day...

"All of our prospects, all of our commitments, all of our targets. We're going to line things up like we always do."

On having two bad losses to Utah...

"They won their match ups. They won their match ups both from a coaching stand point and from an execution stand point. They did a better job than we did and there's no excuse to make. In terms of explanation an the actual scheme, the more you look at film, one was inside zone, why it was successful or why wasn't it. We got ourselves in third-and-8-plus and we were at one point in the game one-for-nine on third down. That was a recipe for a bad night. That was something we really poured a lot of time into, to put yourselves in good third down situations by having more efficient first and second down plays. We thought we schemed that up well. A couple of penalties hurt us, as did an errant snap in the second half. They played well, but we hurt ourselves, as well. But the recipe to change the result of this game was to do better on first and second down and we didn't. We attacked it a couple of different ways and felt we had some good adjustments but they weren't good enough."

Opening Statement

"Very proud of our guys for putting the punctuation on the last Pac-12 game of the year. [It's] very difficult to beat a team twice, especially a team the caliber of Oregon. They're a heck of a group; they've got a ton of talent. For our guys to be able to do that 13 days ago and then turn around and do it again, that lets you know how tough those guys are, how determined, and the high character level these guys have. It's been a pleasure to coach them all year long. What we've been through this year – it's been the most difficult year of my coaching career in many respects. Our guys and our leadership - we couldn't have done it without those guys. The leaders and the seniors and the upperclassmen did such a great job all season long of persevering. Our mantra after the tragedy was, 'We're not going to get over it, but we'll get through it.' I believe our guys really did that and, like I said, couldn't be prouder of them. I haven't seen the final numbers, but I know our defense was suffocating up until they got a few yards in the fourth quarter. I think they only had 150 yards through three [quarters], if I read the board correctly. Cam Rising – what a story that kid has been this year. He was the second-string quarterback the first three games and just persevered, prepared like he was the starter, had a great attitude. When he got his shot, he made the most of it and the rest is history. It's a history-making football at Utah; we've never won the Pac-12, so I'm proud of them for that. In the convincing fashion that they did it, if you had told me that after three games that we'd be here right now, I would have said you were crazy. These guys buckled down and we went 9-1 the rest of the way after those first three. Couldn't be prouder. Just a year that's filled with so many ups and downs. Ty and Aaron – we love those two young men. They were with us tonight; I'm positive of that, that they were here."

On <u>Devin Lloyd's</u> impact on the team ...

"His impact and value cannot be overstated. He is such a leader, such a pure talent. He could have come out last year and been a first or second round draft choice. I think he's probably played his way into the top 10 or 12 in the first round. That's what I'm hearing. He came back and he was a man on a mission. He came back and he wanted to win a championship and he wanted to be an All-American. He had these goals. He sat down and told me all of his goals when we had the meeting about a year ago. 'I'm coming back and here's why and here's what I want to accomplish'. He's checked every box so far."

On difference between this team and others that have advanced to the Pac-12 FCG

"They handled adversity all season long; the resiliency that they've shown all season long has been incredible. A handful of our guys were with us for those two previous championship games, '18 and '19. Devin and [Britain Covey] and maybe another 10 or 12 guys. They were not to be denied this time around. They had a big influence on the rest of the football team. The practices all season long were outstanding, especially when we started to get some momentum. This team was governed from within and I can't say enough good things about the leadership and the coaching staff. I think we have one of the best assistant coaching staffs in the country. Morgan Scalley, Andy Ludwig did a great job playing off of their games from 13 days ago and adding some little, subtle changes and some tweaks and some modifications that really complemented what we did 13 days ago. It was great to see that gameplan come to fruition. Of course, it's the players who execute it. Couldn't be prouder of our staff and that's not only the coordinators, but all the position coaches all the way through."

On being able to beat Oregon again ...

"We had the same mentality and mindset and focus and look in their eye that they had two weeks ago. I think in

either of those games, I don't think it would have mattered who we were playing. These guys were absolutely locked in and on a mission. They were not going to be denied. As talented and as good a football team as Oregon is – they beat Ohio State at Ohio State, they were third in the nation at one time. They're a talented crew. I don't know how you can say it, but they were very determined, very motivated."

Junior Linebacker Devin Lloyd

What are you feeling right now?

"It's really surreal right now. It's slowly coming to me. I'm just so excited and filled with joy and excitement for everyone on the team who's sacrificed these last nine months just giving everything they have. This is the outcome of that and I couldn't be any more proud of my team."

On what it means to win this for Ty Jordan and Aaron Lowe ...

"It's as satisfying as it gets, just to know that we did honor them the right way. Up to this point we did everything we can, for them. It's as satisfying as it gets."

On whether what this team has been through prepared them for the adversity they faced tonight...

"I definitely believe it did. It built a lot of toughness in us and resiliency. But at the same time, I also believe that [Aaron and Ty] were there, guiding us throughout the whole season, and that they were able to help us create things that I don't think we ever would've done without them. Them being there with us throughout the season just helped us tremendously. But also, the resiliency of everyone on the team to endure something like that and still find a way to fight back and get to this point is just incredible."

On the pick-six...

"I think [Brown] was feeling a little bit of pressure and so he just tried to squeeze it in there. But I was feeling the route in front of me the whole time and I just jumped it. It was an incredible feeling just to help my team and give them a boost of momentum. I think we scored right after that, or not too long after that. Just to give my team a boost and help them, especially early on, is definitely an incredible feeling."

On not being shaken by facing an opponent twice in a season...

"I believe the majority of this team has been through an experience like that. A lot of these guys were there in 2019. We knew what the atmosphere was going to be like. Having a lot of Utah fans helped as well. Something we preached all week was that we can't let the game get bigger than what it is. Because it is still a football game. As much as everything's on the line, it's still a football game. I think everyone just did a great job of handling that and understanding that as long as we played like we've been playing all season, we'll be successful."

On the amount of Utah fans in attendance...

"I think we have the best fans in the nation. I just love the way they travel. Even at home they've been showing up all year. It was no surprise to me when they all showed up. They were loud the whole game, and there the whole game."

Sophomore Quarterback Cameron Rising

On what it means to win this for Tv Jordan and Aaron Lowe ...

"Right with what Devin said. It etches their name[s] in history too. That's really what we talked about doing all year, and really wanted to get done...I'm grateful for this team."

On getting past some of the turnovers and keeping the offense flowing...

"We always talk about having a one play at a time type mentality, and really just focus on that. Things aren't always going to go your way over the course of a game. You just have to stay with it and keep believing. That's what the heart of this team is. We always believe we can do it, no matter the circumstances. That's why we're so successful. "We just try to go out every chance we get, and make sure that we're taking advantage of whatever situation we're facing. The last play doesn't matter, whether it was a touchdown, a pick, we've just got to go onto the next."

On the amount of Utah fans in attendance...

"I was expecting that. I knew the Utes were going to travel, and they were going to do a great job getting down here and making sure they were there at the start. We were out there about two hours before, and we were already seeing a bunch of red out there in the crowd with some little speckles of green. But we definitely had a sea of red out there, and that definitely was in our favor."

Junior Defensive End Mika Tafua

On the 2019 championship setback to Oregon, then beating the Ducks twice this season...

"It's nice to be on the other side of it, you know? [And] have the confetti fall on us. It really hasn't kicked in yet. But it's fun celebrating with all the guys. Definitely well-deserved for everyone. Everyone worked hard, everyone prepared. I think this is a great storybook ending to a great season."

On whether the 2018 and 2019 championship games give this one a greater sense of satisfaction...

"For sure. In our players' meeting the night before the game, I got up and told everyone that that feeling's not something that you want to feel. But I believe that we can do it. And everyone just needs to believe. I feel that everyone bought in, everyone believed, and we saw the result of that tonight. Everyone was playing together. When the offense was slacking, the defense picked up. I feel like we played great team football."

On holding Oregon under 100 rushing yards in both meetings...

"I thought of this motto: if we stop the run, then we can have fun. We can start pass rushing, getting to the quarterback. But we're not going to be able to do that if we can't stop the run. Everybody just bought in, assignment-sound football. Nobody's perfect, but for the most part everyone was executing. That's all a good run defense is, is execution. I feel like we did that."

On what it means to win this for Ty Jordan and Aaron Lowe...

"Those are our brothers. We had a lot of motivation going into the season. But losing Aaron in the middle of the season, that was tough. Especially someone that was around us, who was really close to Ty. For something tragic like that to happen definitely motivated everyone. Like we say, 22% better every day. This was for them. This really was for <u>Aaron Lowe</u> and <u>Ty Jordan</u> so that we could etch their name[s] in history. If we didn't win tonight, it would've just been a cool story. But now, when they look at the 2021 Pac-12 Champions, they'll always remember 22, and <u>Aaron Lowe</u> and <u>Ty Jordan</u>."

On the fan turnout...

"It's almost like we were at Rice-Eccles. I feel like we would've had more if they sold more tickets to the Utah fans. You could tell the difference between our third downs and their third downs. That helps the defense a lot, the crowd noise. It was definitely an advantage for us to have lots of fans there. I'm glad we were able to give them something to remember, a good show."
