2014 SEATTLE SEAHAWKS

LOOKBACK - Pete Carroll completely overhauled the roster in 4Y and they have improved each ssn during his tenure. LY they had some key FA acquisitions and were clearly one of the favorites to win the SB in the pre-ssn. They started the ssn 11-1 before splitting out their final 4 gms. Their 13-3 overall mark was good enough to give them home field advantage in the strongest home venue in the league today (15-1 L/2 yrs). After narrow home victories against the Saints and 49ers in the Divisional and NFC Championship rounds, SEA dismantled the Broncos in the SB from the 1st play on as they held them to 306 yds and 8 pts (151 yds and 30 pts under their regular ssn avg) and claimed their 1st Lombardi Trophy in franchise history.

OFFENSE - The Seahawks have been pretty consistent in Russell Wilson's 2 yrs with B2B #17 finishes in ttl offense (339 ypg LY). Wilson's individual numbers were also nearly identical to his rookie campaign as in '12 he threw for 3,118 yds (64%, 26-10) while adding 489 rush (5.2) and LY threw for 3,357 yds (63%, 26-9) while adding 539 rush (5.6). SEA is a run first offense (finished 1st in rush att's in 2012 and 2nd in 2013) and deservedly so with Marshawn Lynch in the backfield. The Seahawks finished 4th in the NFL last ssn with 137 ypg (4.3) with Lynch surpassing the 1,000+ yd mark for a 3rd straight ssn here including having 39 ttl td's in that span. The backup spot behind Lynch is set with 2013 2nd Rnd DC Christine Michael as the primary along with Robert Turbin. Michael has drawn considerable praise from the coaching staff this offseason and there is some growing concern with Lynch now having more than 1.800 career carries. SEA traded away their 1st Rnd pick in '13 to acquire Percy Harvin but hip surgery saw him play in just 1 regular ssn gm (1 catch). His impact was felt however vs DEN as he had an 87 yd KR td to open the 2H of the SB while also posting 45 yds on a pair of fly-sweeps. Golden Tate was the tm's leading receiver (898, 14.0) but the play of Doug Baldwin (778, 15.6) gave the front office enough confidence to allow Tate to walk following the ssn with a now healthy Harvin. SEA also adds in 2nd Rd DC Paul Richardson while also boasting a solid duo of TE's (Zach Miller and Luke Willson) who combined for 53 catches a ssn ago. Despite having a mobile QB like Wilson, the OL all'd 44 sks (#20 LY), however much of that could be attributed to Wilson's inexp in the pocket and refusal to throw a lot of bad passes. The projected st'rs for 2014 each started at least 8 cms a ssn ago (tm returns 57 of 80 sts) and as Wilson becomes more aware of his surroundings in the pocket, the OL should see the amount of sks decrease. While the Seahawks did a good job re-tooling their offense with a few FA's and DC's, HC Pete Carroll has already made it abundantly clear that he's not changing a winning formula on offense despite Wilson now having 37 career sts under his belt and wanting more on his shoulders.

DEFENSE - SEA has finished in the Top 10 of ttl defense in each of the past 3 ssns including their #1 performance a ssn ago when they surrendered just 274 ypg (best mark in NFL the past 2 yrs). The Seahawks were 7th in the league in rush defense all'g 102 ypg but do lose a pair of st'rs heading into '14 in Red Bryant and Chris Clemons (26 combined sts). Fortunately, the unit still appears to be in solid shape as the depth on the DL in '13 was among the best in the NFL. A prime example of this would be DE's Michael Bennett and Cliff Avril who only had a combined 5 sts a ssn ago between them yet finished #1 and #2 in team sks with 8.5 and 8 respectively. SEA returns their top 9 tkl'rs in '14 with 4 LB's in that group including leading tkl'r Bobby Wagner (120 tkls) who now has 260 tkls over his 1st 2 ssns. It also helps when you can have a Super Bowl MVP as a bkp and that is the case with Malcolm Smith. The secondary received most of the praise in '13 as they all'd just 172 ypg (59%, league-leading 28 int's) tying the '11 Steelers for the fewest pass vds surrendered since 2009. The 3 returning st'rs to the secondary (Richard Sherman, Earl Thomas and Kam Chancellor) each earned spots on the All-Pro tm while Sherman led the NFL with 8 int and was rewarded with a 4 yr \$57 million contract. While they do face some tough offenses outside of their division in '14 (open up vs GB, SD & DEN), the Seahawks will once again have one of the top defenses in all of the NFL.

SPECIAL TEAMS - After a #1 finish in Carroll's 1st ssn in '10, the Seahawks have come back to reality in our ST rankings including a #24 performance LY. A healthy Harvin, who had just 1 return a ssn ago will certainly help this year as he has 5 career KR td's and is expected to take over both return duties in '14. Steven Hauschka hit 24-27 (89%) in '12 and followed that up a ssn ago by hitting on 33-35 (94%, #2 NFL). P Jon Ryan did see his numbers dip a bit (45.6, 40.8 net '12) to 42.7 (39.2 net). Everyone but PR Tate returns TY giving SEA a solid chance to move up in our rankings this ssn.

OVERVIEW - The NFL is well know for being a copycat league and the Seahawks model is spreading rapidly amongst tms. SEA lost 6 st'rs and 10 ply'rs overall from LY's SB winning team, and it seems the NFL punished them because of their strong homefield edges as they didn't give them a single SNF/MNF home game. SB winners usually get one of the toughest sked the following yr and this yr is no diff (#9) as the Seahawks open up vs 3 playoff tms in GB, SD and DEN. They also have 3 tough road gms in their final 5 incl having only 4 days to prep for their Thanksgiving night showdown at revenging SF. There are also several factors pointing down as they benefitted from a league-best +20 TO's LY while also having beneficial offensive and defensive ypp's along with 2 net close wins. Despite all this, the Seahawks still have most of their remaining key pieces from LY, now have a healthy Harvin on offense and they have a solid shot at becoming just the 2nd team in the new millennium to repeat as SB champs joining NE ('03-'04).

2014 SAN FRANCISCO 49ers

LOOKBACK - All the 49ers have done in the Jim Harbaugh era is post a 36-11-1 overall record and earn a spot in 3 consecutive NFC Championship gms (SB appearance in '12). After a road win vs GB to open the ssn, the 49ers shockingly suffered B2B blowout losses to SEA and IND as the 49ers struggled to transition to a passing team. They would win their next 5 gms by 23 ppg by getting back to basics but then had 2 losses by a comb 4 pts. They would close out their ssn w/6 str wins but finished 2nd to SEA in the division and would have to play on the road throughout the playoffs. After notching wins over GB and CAR, the 49ers were driving for the winning td in Seattle with a trip to SB48 on the line. However, SF was int'd on a tremendous tip play by Richard Sherman and would go on to lose 23-17, which marked the 3rd str ssn they have come up just short.

OFFENSE - While the 49ers saw their ttl offense ranking drop from #11 to #24 LY, their ppg a ssn ago actually improved for a 4th consecutive ssn (17.5 to 25.4 LY). After leading the 49ers to SB 47 (took over for Alex Smith in '12 during bye wk) Colin Kaepernick started all 16 gms in 2013 throwing for 3,197 yds (58.4%) with a 21-8 ratio while also rushing for 524 yds (5.7, 4 td). While he did receive a lucrative extension it's really a team friendly contract Kaepernick is on. While Frank Gore is still penciled in as the st'r here after yet another 1,000 yd ssn (7th in 8 yrs), this unit is stacked with highly drafted talent as the 49ers have now picked a RB in the top 4 rounds in each of the last 4 ssns. Carlos Hyde (#2 DC) is the newest member of the group after becoming the 1st RB in Urban Meyer's HC career to top 1,000 yards rushing. LaMichael James has been relegated to more of a ST's role but Marcus Lattimore finally appears to be past his gruesome leg inj of '12 at South Carolina and could challenge Hyde and LY's bkp Kendall Hunter for some PT in the backfield. Needless to say it's one of the deepest RB corps in the league. OC Greg Roman was unable to use 3 and 4-WR sets in 2013 due to the lack of healthy players at the position making it tough for Kaepernick to find functional targets for a good portion of the yr. With Michael Crabtree now 100% and Vernon Davis still in the debate as one of the top TE's in the league, this unit can be dangerous in '14 esp with both players jockeying for new contracts. SF also dealt a low draft pick to pull in a quality WR for a 2nd straight ssn (Anguan Boldin '13) with the addition of Stevie Johnson. Throw in the drafting of speedy Bruce Ellington and the 49ers now have the ability to expand the passing game and relinquish some of the gimmick formations that they've been forced to utilize in the last couple of yrs to keep the offense productive. SF had the #3 rush offense in the NFL LY (138 ypg, 4.4) and should be as effective in '14 assuming they find a starting C as Daniel Kilgore and rookie 3rd rounder Marcus Martin will be in a legit TC battle for the spot. The unit returns 64 of their 80 sts from LY and still remains one of the top OL's. Assuming the offense as a whole maintains better health, the 49er offense could see their ppg improve for a 5th straight year.

DEFENSE - SF has boasted a top 5 defense in each of the past 3 ssns including a #5 finish in '13 that saw them allow just 317 ypg. 2008 was the last year that the 49ers surrendered more than 100 ypg on the ground (96 ypg, 3.9 in '13) and that trend may end in 2014 as while the front-3 returns intact led by DE Justin Smith, the LB corps has plenty of questions. Leading tkl'r NaVorro Bowman (145) will likely begin the ssn on the PUP after a major knee inj in the playoffs and OLB Aldon Smith (42 sks in 3Y) has a substantial suspension in his future. Patrick Willis returns to the group and has tallied 100+ tkls in 6 of his 7 ssns (97 in '11) while Ahmad Brooks also returns after tying Smith for the tm lead in sks LY (8.5). The tm did post 38 sks for a 2nd consec yr but dropped overall from #11 to #18. The secondary did lose 3 of their 4 st'rs after a #7 pass D performance (221 ypg, 59%, 19-18) but does get two key FA's in return that started a combined 27 sts a ssn ago led by Antoine Bethea. Jimmie Ward, who was selected in the 1st Rnd of the draft will provide quality depth. Assuming that the LB corps is able to hold up until both Bowman and Smith return, the SF defense will still continue to be a solid group although another top 5 finish seems a bit unlikely for 2014.

SPECIAL TEAMS - Brad Seely is one of the best ST's coordinators in the game today and his #2 finish in our rankings a ssn ago is a prime example. LY the 49ers added an underrated K Phil Dawson from CLE and he would go on to convert 32 of 36 att's, a huge improvement from what David Akers did here in '12 (29-42). Andy Lee is in the discussion for being one of the top P's in the league today as he once again found himself in the top 5 in both avg (48.2) and net (41.7). All the key contributors return again in '14 including LaMichael James who had a 26.8 KR and 10.9 PR avg. The 49ers are clearly one of the elite ST's units in the NFL.

OVERVIEW - The 49ers 36-11-1 record the last 3 seasons is 2nd only to NE's 37-11 mark but like NE, they have nothing to show for it when it comes to the Lombardi Trophy. TY the hope is that the offense will be more diversified with a healthy rec corps but the health of the defense particularly at LB raises some red flags. While the 49ers always rank near the top of the NFL in TO margin, they also had positive offensive and defensive ypp's and only outgained their foes by 7 ypg a year ago which is more indicative of a 8-8 or 9-7 team (-52 ypg vs foes that finished w/a winning record). The sked sees opening up at a rebuilding DAL tm followed by 3 HG's in the next 4 all vs tms who won 8 or more gms LY. They have three B2B road trips on the ssn incl road trips vs DEN and NO in non-div play. They do finish with 2 str HG's on the ssn. Three straight trips to the NFC Championship is a tremendous feat and there is no question the 49ers will be one of the NFL's elite teams yet again as they open their new stadium. The big question however is whether that grind of 3 consecutive runs deep into the postssn will end up catching up to them in '14.




