

POSITION OUTLOOK FOR 2015

QUARTERBACKS - In '12 Tyler Russell (PS#7) replaced a 2Y st'r. He had 4 sts in '11 and in '12 became the first MSU QB to be chosen for the Maxwell Award Watch List and broke/tied 11 schl records (13 st, 2897, 59%, 24-10). RFr Dak Prescott (PS#47) played in 12 (194, 62%, 4-0, 118 rush). 2013 was supposed to be Russell's big year but he ply'd in just 7 (inj). The team had been built around Russell's throwing and it took new HC Dan Mullen a few gms to tailor the offense to the more mobile Prescott. Prescott threw for 1,940 (58%, 10-7). He missed 2 and did not start vs Ole Miss (pinched nerve left arm). True frosh Damian Williams (PS#96) hit 8-18-82 while Prescott came off the bench to hit 11-20-115 and guide MSU to the win and bowl eligibility. Williams did have the GW 25 vd td run vs Ark in OT (112, 3.0 rush on yr) in the week prior. Prescott was the team's leading rusher w/829 (6.2, 13 td, 2 td rec). He was a Heisman candidate in '14. threw for 3,449 (61.6%, 27-11, 986 rush, 14 rush td) and was also a Maxwell and O'Brien finalist. Williams ply'd in 6 gms (155 pass, 63 rush). Adding depth TY is good sized rFr Elijah Staley (6'6" 235, PS#60). Prescott turned down a shot at the NFL and is one of the front runners for the Heisman Trophy.

RUNNING BACKS - In '12 the Bulldogs had to replace Vick Ballard (PS#16JC, #5DC, 1189, 6.2) and LaDarius Perkins led the way w/1,024 (5.0). RFr Josh Robinson (PS#78) was the star of bowl practices in '11 but only had 244 before 91 (13.0) in the '12 bowl. In '13 Perkins was never 100% but still led the RB's (542, 4.0) while Robinson had 101 vs Ark (459, 5.9). LY, Robinson (compact, low to the ground, strong, tough runner) rushed for 197 vs LSU and 198 vs UK but just 316 (52.6 vpg) over the last 6. He still led w/1,203 (6.3,370 rec). Bruiser Ashton Shumpert (PS#27, 190, 4.1 '13) st'd getting a bigger share and had 232 over the final 5. Soph Brandon Holloway (5'8" 160) was #3 w/294 (6.5). TY Robinson (11 st) left early for the NFL (#6DC IND) and they also lose Nick Griffin (3 st, 157, 4.0) but do have 3 VHT's to take over in Shumpert, true frosh Nick Gibson (PS#31) and Aeris Williams (6'1" 215 rFr, PS#33)

RECEIVERS - In '13 MSU had to replace their top 4 rec's and the leading returnees were TE Malcolm Johnson (171, 17.1) and WR Robert Johnson (PS#53, 164, 9.6). Jameon Lewis (5'9' PS#107) had 251 (14.8) in his first 2Y but became the feature WR and set a schl record with 220 in the bowl (923, 14.4). R Johnson was #3 w/389 (11.4) and M Johnson was #2 w/391 (13.0). True frosh De'Runnya Wilson had 351 (13.5). 6'4" soph

Joe Morrow (PS#48) was supposed to be the breakaway threat but never emerged (211, 11.7). LY the unit ret'd intact. Wilson had 548 yds (81% of his yds) in 6 gms vs ranked tms and led with 680 (14.5). Fred Ross (PS#29) was #2 w/489 (16.3). Morrow did lead the team in ypc (20.2, just 17 rec). TY they lose Jameon Lewis (9 st, 380, 11.9, missed parts of 5 gm), Ř Johnson (13 st, 227, 16.2), M Johnson (12 st, 380, 13.6, #6DC CLE), and TE Brandon Hill (3 rec). Despite the loss of 3 st'rs, this unit is still in pretty good shape with their top 2 back and they add in PS#5JC WR Donald Gray

OFFENSIVE LINE - In '13 MSU had a veteran O-line (95 car sts) and improved from 144 (4.4) in '12 to 190 rush ypg (4.7, 23 sk) despite some inj's. LY they had to replace a 2nd Tm AA 4Y st'g LG (#3DC) and a 2Y st'g RT but they had 3 ret st'rs (81 car sts) and improved again (233, 5.2, 23 sk). This year they lose 1st Tm SEC RG Ben Beckwith (13 st, 2Y st'r), LT Blaine Clausell (13 st, 3Y st'r), C Dillon Day (12 st, 4Y st'r) and Archie Muniz (1 st). That's 114 car sts gone with just 32 returning. They add in a PS#10JC and Mullen will field a solid O-line despite it being the least experienced group they've had in years.

DEFENSIVE LINE-I thought that MSU had one of the more talented defensive front 7's in college football LY. The Bulldogs only had to replace 1 st'r and ret'd 7 of their top 8. After allowing 144 ypg rush (4.2, 20 sk) in 13, I expected improvement. After 11 gms they had yielded just 119 ypg (3.5) but they were gashed for 657 (7.1) over the final 2 so the season numbers dropped (152, 4.2). On the positive side the sks did rise to 37 and Preston Smith won SEC DL POW 3 consec times. TY the losses are heavy. Gone are 1st Tm SEC DE Smith (13 st, 48 tkl, 9 sk, 6 tfl, #2DC WAS), DT Kaleb Eulls (12 st, 34 tkl, 3 sk), DT PJ Jones (13 st, 31 tkl, 1 sk) and DT Curtis Virges (1 st, 17 tkl). They did rotate plenty of players LY, but they are not as deep and go from 3 ret st'rs to just 1.

LINEBACKERS - LY the Bulldogs had to replace their

#2 tkl'r but had 5 of the top 6 back incl their top LB Benardrick McKinney (#4 tkl'r) as well as Beniquez Brown (PS#50) and Richie Brown (PS#70) who comb for 77 tkl's (7.5 tfl) as bkps. My computer proj'd MSU to allow 22.0 ppg (pg 43) and the Bulldogs allowed 21.7 led by their dominating defensive front 7. TY they lose 1st Tm AA McKinney (13 st, #1 tkl'r, 3 sk, 5 tfl, #2DC HOU), OLB Matthew Wells (13 st, #9 tkl'r, 4 sk, 4.5 tfl, #6DC NE) and Christian Holmes (1 st, #3 tkl'r). They return their #2, #6 and #13 tkl'rs but with just 1 st'r back and the top guy gone, this unit will be down a few notches in '15.

DEFENSIVE BACKS - LY MSU had to replace a 2nd Tm SEC FS (#4 tkl'r) but had 3 st'rs back and also ret'd SS Jay Hughes (3 st '12, inj '13) who beat out Kendrick Market for the SS spot. MSU allowed 273 ypg passing but were up big in the 2H of most games. They only all'd tms to complete 52.3% and had a 17-16 ratio, so they actually finished #39 in my PDR (highest s/10). TY they lose CB Jamerson Love (13 st, 34 tkl, 9 pbu), Hughés (12 st, 26 tkl, 2 int) and FS Justin Cox (8 st, 21 tkl, 1 int, 4 pbu). They return their #4, #5, #7 and #11 tkl'rs but coming off an unusually high finish and with the loss of 3 st'rs, I'll call them down a bit this season.

SPECIAL TEAMS - LY I called for a good sized climb in their ST rankings (#120 in '13). In '13 MSU was 1 of 4 tms to make under 50% of their fg's and after 3 gms LY they were 0-1 on fg's w/2 missed xp's but Evan Sobiesk hit 12-14 fg (L45) after that. Jamoral Graham muffed a punt in 4 consec games and MSU avg just 6.0 on PR's and 19.9 on KR's. Logan Cooke had 15 TB on 54 KO and avg'd 41.4 on 10 punts. Devon Bell (6-14 fg '13) concentrated only on P LY and improved to 43.2 (39.5 tm net!). Overall MSU rose to #53. TY, however, they lose their top KR and more importantly, their K

COACHES - No Miss St HC had evertaken the Bulldogs to 4 straight bowls let alone 5. No Miss St team had ever won 10 games. No Miss St team had ever been ranked #1 and no Miss Stteam had ever gone from unranked to #1 in 3 weeks. But that was prior to Dan Mullen. Mullen, now in his 7th yr here, was Urban Meyer's QB cch at both 14 Tm Net Avg BG and Utah and his OC/QB cch at Florida. The second year co-OC's are Billy Gonzales (WR cch '13, Illinóis co-OC '12) and John Hevesy (MSU OL cch 5 yrs) although Mullen calls his own plays. DC Geoff Collins departed to Florida but former MSU DC Manny Diaz ret's. Diaz's first DC job was at MT ('06-'09) then he was the DC here in '10, at Texas

('11-'13) and at La Tech LY. Greg Knox has been the RB cch here s/'09 and LY added the ST duties to his resume.

ALSO ON ROSTER:

Prior to the Dan Mullen era, MSU went through 7 losing seasons in 8 years avg just 4 wins per season, even with the 8 in '07. The Bulldogs' highest finish in the SEC West had been tied at #3 and in 6 of those 8 years finished #5 or worse (basement 5x's). In '09 Dan Mullen inherited a 4-8 team and his first squad went 5-7 but he's now been to 5 bowls in 5 yrs. It's ironic that had Mullen lost the Egg Bowl in '13 and the team gone 5-7, they probably would have let him go. After winning the Egg Bowl and their bowl over Rice (44-7), MSU was not ranked at the start of 2014 and was picked 5th in the SEC West (media). MSU scored 96 pts, their most in the first 2 gms since scoring 97 pts to begin 1944! After blanking SMiss 49-0, they only beat UAB 47-34. They whipped South Alabama 35-3 and dominated LSU, leading 34-10 before allowing some late scores. They did the same vs A&M leading 48-17 before allowing 2 td's in the final 2:29. Auburn turned it over on their first 2 poss and MSU jumped out to a 21-0 lead and won 38-23. MSU was the first team in history to go from unranked to ranked #1 in just 3 wks as they were NR vs LSU, #12 vs A&M, #3 vs Auburn and #1 vs Kentucky. They handled KY on the road 45-31. They trailed Ark 10-7 at half but won 17-10 with the key play a pass on the left sideline to Fred Ross that he took 69 yds for the lead. The Bulldogs waxed UT Martin 45-16 setting up a #1 MSU at #4 Alabama, a game in which MSU was over a td dog. They trailed 19-3 at half and 25-13 before getting a td with :15 left. MSU thrashed Vanderbilt 51-0, which was their largest MOV in an SEC game s/1936 (they beat Sewanee from TN who played in the SEC from 1933-'40, 68-0). Almost everyone in the country picked them to beat Miss on the road in the Egg Bowl but the Rebels had a 532-445 yd edge and won 31-17. MSU, with an excellent defensive front 7 and extra time to prepare for GTech's option surprisingly yielded 452 yds rushing to lose 49-34 and finish #11. In **2015** MSU has the fewest ret st'rs in the SEC (7), rate a -2.5 in my Stock Market Indicator, are -42 all-conf pts (pg 33) and had a def ypp of 19.6 LY. They do have Heisman contender QB Prescott and a physical front 7 on D. MSU remains one of the top teams in the country but I don't see them matching LY's 10 win total.
