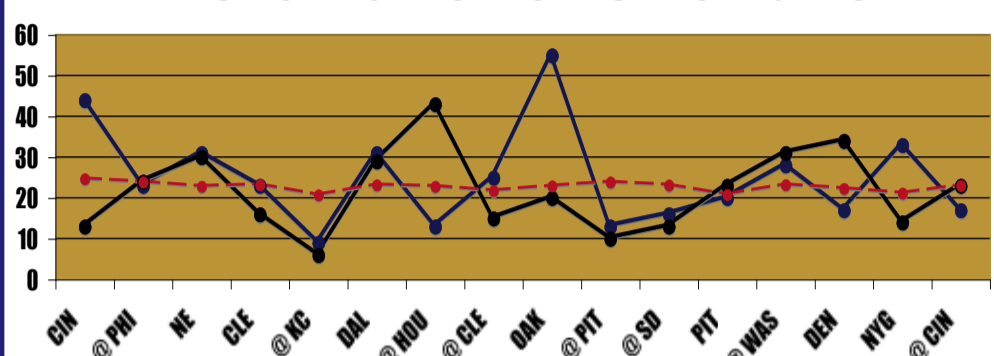
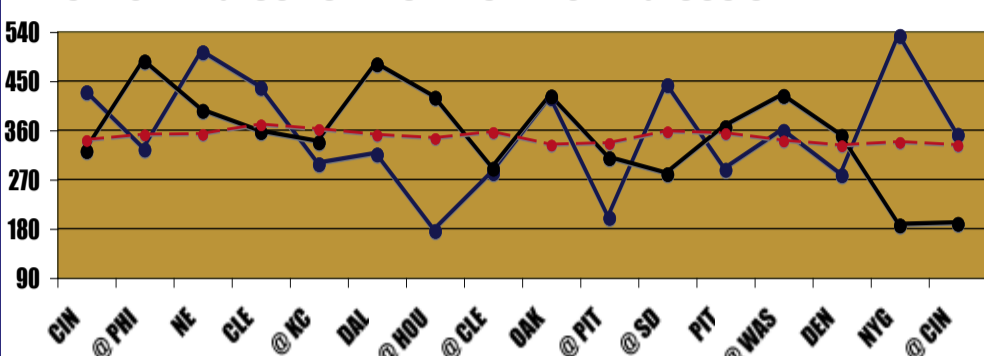

POSITION OUTLOOK FOR 2013

QUARTERBACKS - Joe Flacco took a huge gamble last year as he opted not to sign a contract extension and let his play determine his value. Flacco struggled early in the year hitting 8 of 25 in the 2H vs PHI then just 147 yds (49) and a 1-2 ratio vs HOU. A good portion of this was due to the fact that the play calling had become predictable going through Ray Rice first and not trying to take advantage of Torrey Smith's deep speed. In six games vs a Top 10 defense LY Flacco avg'd 258 ypg (54%) with a 5-5 ratio and a 3-3 record. He did become the first QB in the NFL to take his team to the playoffs in each of his first 5 years (remarkably not missing a single start) and got better as the season went along, excelling in the playoffs. Flacco threw for 1,140 yds with an outstanding 11-0 ratio in the playoffs. Those results and a Super Bowl win had him cash in on a \$120mill contract. He does have a rocket for a right arm and continues to improve but still was only #12 in the NFL in pass eff throwing for 3,817 (59.7%, 22-10). #2 QB Tyrod Taylor is a different breed of QB who is much more mobile and is clearly on the roster as a scout team QB to give the defense a different look. This is now Flacco's team to lead with the departure of several Ravens icons and fans should appreciate their highly paid franchise QB.

RUNNING BACKS - Ray Rice's (#2DC Rutgers) rushing numbers are pretty consistent as he's posted 1220 (4.5), 1364 (4.7) and 1143 (4.4) the last 3 years. That doesn't capture everything as he also has 278 rec the last 4 years with 704 yards receiving in '11 (9.3) giving him over 2,000 total yards of offense that year. LY he had "only" 478 (7.8) but did have the memorable 4th and 29 conversion vs SD which turned the Ravens' season around. His fumble rate is fantastic over the L3Y with 1 every 352 touches. Bernard Pierce (#3DC Temple) was the leading rusher in the final 2 games of the regular season with 123 and 89 yards and then had 103 yards in the opening round of the playoffs. Rice led in 2 of the final 3 getting 131, 48 and then 59 in the Super Bowl. They did let one of the league's top FB's go in 3-time Pro Bowler Vonta Leach (456 snaps) who was cut mid-June. Adding depth are Bobby Rainey (UFA WKU) and Anthony Allen (61, 3.8). Pierce is fully expected to get more carries in 2013 which benefits Rice as it will extend his service life in the long run. This is a top-notch unit but it will be interesting to see how the loss of Leach impacts the run game.

RECEIVERS - The Ravens paid a lot of money to bring in Anquan Boldin to improve the unit in 2010. While he wasn't quite the breakout player the Ravens expected, he did lead the tm in rec each of the L3 seasons including LY w/65 rec for 921 yds (14.2) and 4 td's. Facing cap constraints the Ravens generously sent #1WR Boldin to SF for a #6DC. Boldin had 22 catches for 380 yds and 4 td's in the playoffs. The new #1 WR could be Torrey Smith who had 16 catches of 20+ yds, just 1 fewer than Boldin did LY, and is able to stretch the field vertically. He did have just 49 rec on 110 targets, the worst % (45%) of any player in the league that caught more than 30+ passes while avg 16+ per catch. Jacoby Jones did have a 70 yd td catch in the playoff win over DEN and led the NFL in KR avg (30.7 on 38 att). He along with Smith will be counted on becoming more complete wideouts in 2013. Filling out the rotation will be possession WR Tandon Doss (7 rec LY), the speedy Deonte Thompson and David Reed. The Ravens have a solid 1-2 punch at TE in sure-handed Dennis Pitta who was #2 in receptions LY with 61 (11.0) and 7 td's and Ed Dickson who after recording 54 receptions in '11, had just 21 LY (10.7). While the loss of Boldin leaves this unit without a consistently reliable possession type, it still is above average as a whole.

OFFENSIVE LINE - In '09 with a new C and a rookie OT (#1DC, 23rd overall Michael Oher), the Ravens still finished #5 in the NFL in rush offense but #20 in sacks allowed (36). In '11 they picked up Bryant McKinnie to play LT while allowing Oher to move over to RT. The Ravens improved to #13 in sacks allowed/qbh and were #10 in rushing production. The key to the unit is their guard play with RG Marshal Yanda (#3DC '07) and LG Kelechi Osemele (#2DC '12). LY they were ranked #14 in rushing production and QB sk/hits and seemed to jell even further in the playoffs as they allowed just 6 sacks in the final 4. TY they lose 4 yr starting C Matt Birk who retired and LG Bobbie Williams (6 sts). McKinnie's return to form offsets Birk's departure and they've groomed Gino Gradkowski (#4DC '12) who had 85 snaps LY while Jah Reid (#3DC '11) also started the last 7. This may be BAL's best OL in recent years despite the loss of Birk.

DEFENSIVE LINE - LY was an atypical year for the BAL rush D. They had ranked in the Top 5 in rush D in each of the 6 yrs from '06-'11 including '11 when they yielded just 93 ypg rush (3.5) which was #2 and were also #3 in the NFL in sacks (48). The individual numbers up front showed them just at just #19 in DL sk/tfl and #14 in tfl tkl. Haloti Ngata was a #1DC in '06 and earned a Pro Bowl in '11. He returned LY along with Terrence Cody (#2DC '10) who had 16 sts, 34 tkl in '11 as they only lost DE Cory Redding (11 st, 43 tkl, 4.5 sk). Ma'ake Kemoatu who had 12 sts with WAS in '10 and 0 sts in '11 (inj) started 13 games at DT and had 29 tkl, 1 sk. TY they lose Kemoatu but add in Chris Canty who had 16 sts, 47 tkl, 4 sk with the Giants in '11 and 9 sts, 26 tkl, 3 sk LY as well as Marcus Spears who had 18 sts w/ DAL the last 3 yrs with 60 tkl and 2 sk. Cody was troubled by an injured elbow and started just 4 games and had 25 tkl LY. Arthur Jones, the team's #5DC in '10 had his most productive season w/6 st, 47 tkl, 4.5 sk. They allowed a franchise high 123 ypg (4.0) but did have 37 sk and they were #19 in DL sk/tfl and #4 in DL tkl. The amount of improvement here will depend on how much the disappointing Cody steps up his game with the addition of 3rd RD DC Brandon Williams. This is a restocked unit and the demise of the Ravens defense is erroneous.

LINEBACKERS - In '11 BAL was #4 in the NFL in LB sk/tfl and #6 in LB tkl. Ray Lewis was their #1 tkl'r with 95 (4 tfl), Jameel

McClain was #2 with 84 (3.5 tfl) and Terrell Suggs added 70 tkl, 14 sk, 7.5 tfl. Suggs was injured in the offseason LY and was expected to miss the season. He had a remarkable work ethic and returned to start 8 games. Lewis only started the first 6 because he was inj'd but he still finished with 57 tkl and 1 sk as he played in 4 more before ending up on IR. BAL was #7 in the NFL in LB sk/tfl and #3 in LB tkl despite their top 2 missing so much time. #2DC Courtney Upshaw (Alabama) had 9 st and 60 tkl. There are some major changes from this talented group. Gone are Ray Lewis (retired), situational pass rusher Paul Kruger (9 sk, 6 st, FA), Dannell Ellerbe (7 st, 92 tkl, 4.5 sk, FA) and Brendon Ayanbadejo (43 tkl, 1 sk). They did catch a break due to the faux pas in DEN with Elvis Dumervil, getting to sign him after he had 54 tkl and 11 sk. Suggs will be around all year, although he does enter his 11th season. McClain started 14 in '11 (99 tkl) and had 9 sts LY (62 tkl). Albert McClellan started 11 games (49 tkl). They add in #2DC Arthur Brown (Kansas St). Despite the significant losses, this unit could be just as good if not better in 2013, especially if Suggs (22 tkl, 2 sk) returns to his elite form.

DEFENSIVE BACKS - BAL was #1 in the NFL in def QBR in '11 and #6 in DB int/pbu. LY the unit returned basically intact and added in #4DC Christian Thompson (S Car St) and #5DC Asa Jackson (Cal Poly). Rising CB Lardarius Webb (#3DC '09) had 15 sts, 67 tkl and 20 pbu in '11 but was lost after 6 sts to a torn ACL (25 tkl, 1 int). BAL slipped some to #11 in the NFL QBR and #10 in DB int/pbu. TY the Ravens lose 3 starters including the super safety tandem of FS Ed Reed (#1DC '02, 16 st, 58 tkl, 4 int, 16 pbu) and SS Bernard Pollard (#2DC '06, 13 st, 98 tkl, 2 sk, 1 int) as well as CB Cary Williams (#7DC '09) who had 16 sts, 75 tkl, 4 int, 17 pbu. Corey Graham (#5DC CHI '07) started 8 games in place of Webb and had 60 tkl, 2 int, 8 pbu. They also bring in Michael Huff (#1DC, 7th overall '06 OAK) who had 16 sts, 56 tkl, 2 int, 13 pbu at OAK LY and #1DC Matt Elam (Florida). James Ihedigbo had 12 sts for the Patriots in '11 (69 tkl) but 0 sts, 25 tkl here LY. Jimmy Smith was a #1DC in '11 that has 5 sts, 54 tkl, 2 int and 11 pbu in 2 years. Chykie Brown was a #5DC that has 1 start, 29 tkl, 7 pbu in 2 years. They also add #7DC Marc Anthony (California). If Webb returns to full health, they may not drop that much in the def QBR.

SPECIAL TEAMS - (L3Y #12, #29, #1) HC John Harbaugh was a ST cch for 8Y so after a #5 finish it was surprising to see them fall to #12 and #29 the next 2Y. LY they replaced all but P Sam Koch (#6DC) and he improved from a 38.6 net in '11 (#19) to a 40.8 net LY (#7). Billy Cundiff was only 28-37 in '11 (only 1-6 50+) opening the door for rookie Justin Tucker who was 30-33 incl 4-4 from 50+. The Ravens were #9 in the NFL in KR's in '11 but still signed Jacoby Jones from HOU and he led the NFL, avg 30.7 (2 td's) and BAL finished #2 in KR's overall. Jones also was the PR (9.2, 1 td) but those numbers were avg. Everyone's back so the expectations are high once again.

OVERVIEW - The Ravens overcame a ton of obstacles riding several waves of emotions to surge their way into the playoffs and win their second Super Bowl ring. BAL went into the year knowing there would be a changing of the guard at the end of the season partially due to age but largely due to cap issues. Ozzie Newsome has earned a great reputation for a reason and the Ravens are rather well stocked for 2013. They still need a veteran to replace Boldin and for Oher to stabilize his play. Defensively they are faster, more athletic and upgraded in terms of talent but the leadership void is a question. Their schedule is a challenge with road games at DEN, MIA, CHI and DET and home games vs HOU, GB and MIN and NE. It wouldn't be a surprise to see the finale vs CIN flexed due to playoff implications.
