**OFFENSE** - The Bobcats ret'd 9 Off starters LY and while their overall numbers improved as they remained #3 in both scoring and total offense. This year they return 8 Off starters and add 2 JC's. Last year Texas St ret'd 2 yr starting QB Bradley George (PS#124), who threw for 2,099 (56.9%) with a 16-8 ratio in '07 along with backup QB Clint Toon (299 in '07). George started 10 throwing for 2,660 (60.1%) with a 26-6 ratio while Toon started 3, throwing for 839 (57.9%). George returns for his Sr sn but Toon departs. Last year the Bobcats ret'd their top 7 rushers including '07's SLC Frosh of the Yr, Karrington Bush (1059, 7.6 in '07) and '06's leading rusher Stan Zwinggi (497, 6.7 in '07). Texas St rotated 3 RB's LY led by 1st tm SLC RB Bush (7 st) with 1,065 (7.8) and was #4 rec. Zwinggi (6 st) had 642 (5.6) while RB Alvin Canady had 322 (4.4). Both Bush and Canady return but they must replace Zwinggi and 1st tm SLC FB Blake Burton (148 tkl yds). Texas St ret'd their top 9 rec LY including 1st tm SLC WR Cameron Luke (1035, 17.2 in '07) but WR Cory Scott (#6) RS. They also added Ark transfer John Chaisson (PS#64QB) just prior to the opener. AA Luke was #2 in the SLC with 1,268 (17.4) with 17 TD but departs. They return 4 of their top 5 rec led by WR Mishak Rivas (625, 15.6) add JC TE Woody McClendon (PS#158JC), return WR Scott and WR Chaisson, who played in just 2 gms LY. The OL ret'd 3 starters LY and while their ypg declined slightly their ypc went from 4.9 to 5.2 (sacks 19 to 15). This year they must replace 1st tm SLC C Jeff Bowen. They return 6 OL, who combined for 52 starts LY including 2nd tm SLC RG DJ Hall and add JC Michael Chambers (PS#762JC).

**DEFENSE** - The Bobcats ret'd 6 def starters and 4 of their top 5 tklr LY and added 3 JC and an FBS transfer. They were still last in the SLC in total defense for a 2nd straight year but in DC Fred Bliel's 1st sn improved from #8 to #4 in scoring as they had the #1 red zone D (71.4 % rate). This year they return 5 starters and add 2 JC and 1 FBS transfer but lose 4 of their top 7 tklr incl both of their all-Conf

performers. The DL ret'd 3 players who combined for just 12 st in '07 but added 2 JC's. They allowed 15 ypg less rushing (ypc 5.0 to 4.6) and the D had 23 sacks. The DL loses 3 starters incl 2nd tm SLC DE Donovan King (#6 tklr, 8 tfl). They return DE Travis Houston (#5 tklr, 13 st) who led with 15 tfl incl a tm best 7 sk and add Ariz transfer Ron Jackson (PS#356) and a JC. The LB corps ret'd 4 players who comb for 29 starts in '07 led by SLB Marcus Clark, who was the #1 tklr (71) in '07. This year they must replace SLB Courtney Smith who led with 117 tkl (11 tfl, 2 int). The unit returns 4 LB who combined for 29 starts LY incl WLB Clark (#2 tklr, 8 tfl) and MLB Joe Bell (#4, 5 tfl). The secondary ret'd 2 starters (#3 & #5 tklr in '07) added a JC along with Iowa St transfer Drenard Williams (PS#361RB). They remained last in pass defense allowing a 32-15 ratio. This year they lose 2 starters in FS Jamal Williams (#3 tklr) and 2nd team CB Morris Crosby (#7) who led with 4 int. The unit returns 4 who comb for 29 starts incl CB Drenard Williams who led with 9 pbu and SS Kenneth Hampton (42 tkl, 3 int) and add a JC.

**SPECIAL TEAMS** - The Bobcats had to replace a 1st tm SLC P (45.9 avg) LY. They return P Ben Follis (38.3) and their top returnmen incl 2nd tm SLC RS, KR Karrington Bush, (1055, 25.1, 1 TD). They must replace 2nd tm SLC K Andrew Ireland who hit 14 of 17 FG and had 18 TB.

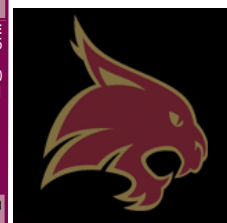
**COACHES** - HC Brad Wright enters his 3rd yr at his alma mater. Co-OC's Travis Bush (6th) and Ben Norton (3rd) both return. DC Fred Bliel is his 2nd yr but will not have a co-DC TY.

**FORECAST** - The Bobcats had just their 3rd winning ssn since '91 and will be trying for their 1st B2B winning ssn since '90-'91. Texas St needed OT in the finale to win the "SLC Championship" (2nd place but UCA could not claim the title) and made only their 2nd trip to the playoffs. However, after making it to the semi-finals in '05, they were knocked out in the FR LY. The Bobcats will need the defense to come together quickly (just 5 starters) to be in the SLC race but should give HC Wright his 2nd winning season.
