TE Luke McDonough was inj and lost for the ssn. They made slight improvements across the board but finished #4 in scoring and #3 in total offense. This year they return 8 Off starters and also get McDonough back. UC Davis had to replace 2 QB's LY who combined for 3,244 (63.1%) with a 25-11. QB Daniel Alfaro, started the opener but played in just 4 other gms throwing for 221 (63.2%) with a 1-2 ratio. QB Greg Denham (PS#151, we proj st'r) took over throwing for 3,478 (65.6%) with a 27-16 ratio and was 2nd tm GW Both return TY. The Aggies ret'd their 2 top rushers LY in RB Joe Trombetta (676, 4.8) in '07 and RB Brandon Tucker, who had 385. This year they return their top 11 rushers led by 2nd tm GW RB Trombetta (8 st, 547, 4.4) who played in just 8, Tucker (2 st, 358, 4.5) who played in just 7 and Corbin Cutshaw (2 st, 282, 5.1). Last year UC Davis 7 of their top 8 rec led by WR's Brandon Rice, who had 870 (14.7) in '07 and Bakari Grant, who had 621 (13.2). This year they return 8 of their top 9 rec including 1st tm GW WR Chris Carter (768, 11.1), 2nd tm GW WR Grant (720, 11.8), 1st tm GWTE Dean Rogers ((178, 13.7) and return TE McDonough. However, they must replace 2nd tm GW WR Rice, who again led with 832 (15.1). The OL returned four 11 gm starters LY and their ypc increased from 3.3 to 3.6 but they did allow 25 sacks. This year they must replace two 12 gm starters in 1st tm GW RG Jon Compas and 2nd tm GW LG Mario Gonzales. They return 4 QL who combined for 36 starts LY including 1st tm GW C Tommy Hernandez and 2nd tm GW LT Mark Tos.

DEFENSIVE - The Aggies ret'd 6 def starters LY and were much tougher allowing 4.5 ppg and almost 80 ypg less. They only had 1 tm (conf champ Cal Poly) score over 30 pts against them. This year the D again returns 7 starters and while they lose 4 of their top 11 tklr, they lose just 1 other player who recorded a tackle (1) LY and return 5 of the top 6. The DL

OFFENSE - The Aggies looked to return 7 off starters LY but ret'd just 2 of 4 starters but allowed almost 50 ypg less rush-TE Luke McDonough was inj and lost for the ssn. They made ing as the ypc went from 4.2 to 3.8 (24 sk). This year the DL returns 4 players who combined for 36 starts LY including 2nd tm GW DE Pat Michelier (#2 tklr, 10 tfl) and sack leader DE Steven Wulff (30 tkl, 7 sk). They do lose 1st tm GW DT John Faletoese (32 tkl, 5.5 sk). The LB corps returned 2 starters, who were the teams top 2 tklr. This year they again return two starters in MLB Mike Morales (#1 tklr, 9 tfl, 2 int) and WLB Mike Healey (#5 tklr, 5 tfl). They must replace 3 yr starting SLB Tyler Pringle (#3 tklr). The secondary ret'd 2 starters LY and at gave up over 30 ypg less passing but allowed a poor 30-10 ratio. This year the secondary loses 2 starters (#7 & #11 tklr). They return 5 who combined for 31 stars LY including 2nd tm GW CB Jeremy Scott (#6 tklr, 7 pbu).

SPECIAL TEAMS - UC Davis had to replace their top PR K

and P LY. P Brett Dickerson (39.5 ypp) had 4 blkd punts in the L/6 gms and WR Chris Miller took over but only avg 34.4 ypp and both depart. They return their top KR, Josh Reese (19.2), top PR Sean Creadick (8.1) and 2nd tm GW

K Sean Kelley, who hit 10 of 13 FG (L/36) as a rFR. **COACHES -** HC Bob Biggs enters his 17th season. DC Steve "Lou" Bronzan enters his 20th. Mike Moroski enters his 21st year leading the Off and Co-OC Rich Scangarello enters his 8th.

FORECAST - After 37 straight winning seasons, UC

Davis has now had 2 straight losing seasons for the
first time since '68-'69. They had 7 losses last year but 2 were against FBS teams (lost by comb 11 pts), 2 were against FCS playoff teams including losing by just 5 to eventual runner-up Montana (led 24-23 late 4Q) and they lost by just 3 to Southland leader Central Arkansas. The Aggies return 15 starters and a '07 starter (inj LY). They have plenty of depth just about everywhere. They do face 2 FBS and 3 Big Sky Opp, but should return to their winning ways and they do get to host Cal Poly on Nov 7th which could be the GW Championship game.
