29 NY JETS OLB JERRY HUGHES TCU OLB, NT, DE, WR

The Jets could address the WR spot here but Rex Ryan's #1 defense from LY needs to find a starter opposite OLB Calvin Pace. Hughes will need a year to make the transition from DE to OLB but he's a huge upgrade over Vernon Gholston.

30 MINNESOTA DT JARED ODRICK PENN ST DT, CB, S, LT

Pat Williams has hinted that he's going to play as long as Brett Favre will. Odrick immediately becomes the #3 DT for the Vikings & provides insurance if either starting DT is suspended to start 2010.

31 INDIANAPOLIS CTR MAURKICE POUNCEY FLORIDA OG, CTR, CB, OLB

The interior of the Colts OL was taken to task in the Super Bowl & GM Bill Polian has stated it's a priority in the draft. Pouncey will play OG in 2010, learn the system & is a like replacement for Jeff Saturday in 2011.

32 NEW ORLEANS DE EVERSON GRIFFEN USC DE, OLB, DT, S

The Saints released Charles Grant & replaced him with former Bear Alex Brown with a 2 year contract. Griffen comes in as the #3 DE, provides insurance incase Will Smith is suspended & is a 2011 starter.
