POSITION OUTLOOK FOR 2010

QUARTERBACKS - In '08 the Tribe ret'd 22 gm starting QB Jake Phillips, who threw for 2,801 (57%, 19-7) and was the #3 rusher (192) in '07. Phillips started 10 in '08, was 3rd Tm CAA throwing for 2,243 (61%, 21-17) and was again the #3 rusher (170) but departed. Backup QB RJ Archer started 1 and threw for 387 (53%, 3-1) with 90 rush yds and ret'd. Archer started all 13 in '09 and was 2nd Tm CAA, throwing for 2,778 (60.3%, 16-9) and rushed for 255 (2.5, 5 TD) but now departs. They return backup Terrance Schmand (7 att, 57 yds pass) and add North Carolina transfer Mike Paulus (PS#6) who was in for spg.

RUNNING BACKS - The Tribe ret'd 8 of their top 9 rushers in '08 including their top rusher, TB Courtland Marriner (518, 4.5). They ret'd 4 of their top 5 rushers in '09 including #4 Marriner (141, 4.9) and 2nd Tm CAA TB Jonathan Grimes (CAA Off Rookie of the Yr) with 929 (5.7, 7 TD) who was also the #5 rec (314, 8.1). This year they return their top 3 rushers in 1st Tm CAA Grimes (1294, 4.7, 9 TD), Courtland Marriner (458, 4.9, 7 TD) and Terrence Higgins (290, 5.1).

RECEIVERS - They ret'd 4 of their top 5 rec in '08 including 3rd Tm CAA WR Elliott Mack, who led with 849 (18.5) and WR DJ McAulay who had 162 yds in the opener before being lost for the ssn (inj). They dropped from #2 to #4 in passing. In '09 they lost WR Mack who had 445 (15.3) in just 8 gms but ret'd 4 of the top 5 including 3rd Tm CAA WR McAulay, who led with 718 (18.0, 8 TD) and 2nd Tm CAA TE Ron Varno (397, 11.0). They again dropped 2 spots to #6. They lose their leader 2nd Tm CAA WR McAulay (620, 10.9) and 2nd Tm CAA TE Rob Varno (467, 9.3). They return 4 of the top 6 rec led by Cameron Dohse (566, 18.9) and Chase Hill (469, 13.8).

OFFENSIVE LINE - The OL had to replace 2 st's in '08 incl a 3rd Tm CAA RT but moved up from #11 to #7 in rushing as the ypc increased from 3.3 to 4.9 and the sacks allowed fell from 31 to 20. They ret'd 3 OL in '09 who each started 10 gms or more in '08. While they moved up to #3 in rushing their ypc went down to 4.1. They allowed 2 more sacks (22, 5%), but did play 3 more gms. This year they return 3 st's who each started 13+ gms but lose two 14 gm starters incl 2nd Tm CAA C CJ Muse.

DEFENSIVE LINE - The DL ret'd 3 of 4 st's in '08 led by DE Adrian Tracy (63 tkl) who led in tfl for a 2nd straight yr (9.5). The rush D improved from #12 to #6 as they allowed 71 ypg less and the ypc fell from 4.8 to 3.9 with 25 sacks. The DL ret'd all 4 st's in '09 led by 1st Tm CAA DE Tracy (#3 tkl'r) who led again with 15.5 tfl. They were #1 in the FCS allowing just 61 ypg rush with a 2.0 ypc

and the D led the CAA with 49 sks. The DL loses 3 st's including two 1st Tm CAA DL, who were both drafted in DT Sean Lissemore (#4 tkl'r, 14 tfl, #7DC DAL) and DE Tracy (#3 tkl'r, #6DC NYG), who led again with 22 tfl including a CAA best 12 sks. They return 3 DL who combined for 17 st's and 9.5 sks LY with each having 20+ tkl's led by DT Michael Stover (#8 tkl'r, 12 tfl).

LINEBACKERS - The LB unit ret'd 2 st's in '08 including #2 tkl'r ILB Josh Rutter (95 tkl). They ret'd #2 tkl'r OLB Jake Trantin (76 tkl, 6.5 tfl) in '09 but lost 2 starters in 3rd Tm CAA ILB Rutter (#5 tkl'r) and OLB Michael Pigram (#4 tkl'r). This year they return 4 LB's who comb for all 42 st's and who were all top 10 tkl'r's led by 2nd Tm CAA ILB Jake Trantin (#1 tkl'r, 10 tfl, 3 int), OLB Evan Franks (#2 tkl'r, 7.5 tfl) and OLB Wes Steinman (#7 tkl'r, 11.5 tfl).

DEFENSIVE BACKS - The secondary ret'd all 4 st's in '08 including 3rd Tm CAA CB Derek Cox and W Mich transfer FS Robert Livingston (#3 tkl'r). While they allowed just 4 pass ypg more they fell from #1 to #3 in pass defense. They ret'd 3 st's in '09 including #1 tkl'r SS David Caldwell (78 tkl, 6 tfl, 2 int) but had to replace 2nd Tm CAA CB Cox, who was a #3DC. They moved up to #2 in pass D allowing a 12-16 ratio. This year they lose 2 st's in 1st Tm CAA SS Caldwell (#5 tkl'r) and FS Livingston (#6 tkl'r). They return their top 3 CB's incl Ben Cottingham (#9 tkl'r) and CAA DE Rookie of Year CB BW Webb (23 tkl, 2nd Tm CAA) who led the CAA with 8 int.

SPECIAL TEAMS - They ret'd 3 all-CAA special teams players LY in K Brian Pate (1st Tm), P David Miller (3rd Tm) and KR Jonathan Grimes (1st Tm, 1 TD) but lost PR Derek Cox (16.4 avg, 2 TD). This year they lose 2nd Tm CAA K Pate (23 of 35 FG) but again return three all-CAA players in P Miller (1st Tm), PR Webb (3rd Tm) and KR Grimes (3rd Tm).

COACHES - HC Jimmye Laycock enters his 31st yr as HC and is off his 20th winning ssn. Zbig Kepa enters his 18th yr as OC and 27th overall here. DC Bob Shoop enters his 4th ssn.

FORECAST - The off ret'd 7 starters in '09 including their leading rusher but had to replace a 32 gm starting QB but still finished #5 in scoring and #3 in total off. This year they return 6 off starters including their top 3 rushers and 4 of their top 6 receivers. While they must replace their starting QB again they add a VHT FBS transfer to compete for the open spot. The defense ret'd 8 starters LY and despite having to replace a DC, the defense was the reason the Tribe made the playoffs. They led the FCS in rush D and were #2 in the FCS in both scoring and total defense. This year the D returns just 6 starters and loses 4 of their top 6 tkl'r's including 2 DC's. They do return 11 of their top 16 tkl'r's including their top 2. The Tribe tied a school record with 11 victories LY ('04) including an opening win over Virginia and while they made just their 2nd playoff appearance in the last 6 yrs, they again made it to the semifinals losing both times to a fellow conf tm that went on to win the Championship. W&M finished #3 LY and came within a point of the Championship gm. They were +11 in TO after being -10 in '08, which was a big part of their improvement. This year in the 10 tm CAA they don't play Towson and face Maine, UNH and JMU on the road. How well the defense comes together will determine if W&M can make their 9th playoff trip under HC Laycock.
