POSITION OUTLOOK FOR 2010

QUARTERBACKS - The Gamecocks had to replace QB Cedric Johnson (1434, 57%, 6-5, 437 rush) in '08. They brought in LSU trans Ryan Perrilloux (PS#1) and true frosh Marques Ivory (PS#151). Perrilloux threw for 2,318 (63%, 19-13) and was the #2 rusher (368, 3.1, 7 TD) earning 2nd Tm OVC honors. Ivory added 127 (58%, 2-0) and both returned in '09. Perrilloux threw for 2,350 (58.5%) with an outstanding 23-2 ratio while rushing 443 (4.5, 8 TD) and was the OVC OPOY but departs. Ivory started the opener (Perrilloux susp) and in 9 games threw for 315 (65.0%, 4-1) with 50 yds (2.1) rushing. Ivory returns and they add true frosh Coty Blanchard (PS#114).

RUNNING BACKS - In '08 JSU ret'd 7 of their top 8 rushers led by Daniel Jackson (509, 3.9) and FB Alphonso Freeney (140, 3.3). Jackson led with 815 (6.4) but departed LY. In '09 their top returning RB's were Brandon George (206, 6.4), FB Freeney (169, 5.8) and Calvin Middleton (75, 4.7). They also added JC Jamal Young. George started the F/3 (played 8) but rushed for just 56 (3.3). This year they ret their top 2 in Middleton (629, 5.0) and Young (523, 5.2) along with FB Freeney (99, 4.9).

RECEIVERS - The Gamecocks lost their top 3 WR's in '08 who comb for 989 in '07 and their top returning WR was James Wilkerson with just 190 (13.6). With the addition of QB Perrilloux they improved from #8 to #2 in passing. Maurice Dupree led with 799 (16.3) but departed. In '09 their top returnee was Wilkerson with 516 (16.1). JSU again finished #2 in passing led by 1st Tm OVC WR Wilkerson (716, 19.9) and GT Transfer Greg Smith (485, 16.2) but they both depart. They ret Alan Bonner (300, 21.4), James Shaw (281, 14.8) and LaRay Williams (270, 18.0) along with 2nd Tm OVC TE Cory Freeman (42, 7.0).

OFFENSIVE LINE - In '08 the OL ret'd 3 s't's and added 2 JC's and despite switching to a passing offense and having to adjust to the different blocking schemes they improved from #7 to #2 in rushing as their ypc went from 3.8 to 4.8 but they allowed 9 more s'ks (29, 9.3%). In '09 they again ret'd 3 s't's with former JC C Reggie Wade, LT Curt Porter and LG Matt Jones, who had 11 s't's as a true. They moved up to #1 in rushing but the ypc remained 4.8 but they cut the s'ks allowed to 24 (8.0%). They lose 2nd Tm OVC C Wade but return 5, who comb for 44 s't's LY incl 1st Tm OVC RT Tylor Chambers, 2nd Tm OVC LT Porter and LG Jones.

DEFENSIVE LINE - The DL ret's 2 of 3 s't's in '08 and added Southern Miss transfer Jamison Wadley (PS#150). Surprisingly they fell from #1 to #5 in rush D as the ypc went from 3.8 to 4.5 despite the D having 39 s'ks (37 in '07). In '09 the DL ret'd 3 with starting exp with Brandt Thomas (#9 tkl'r, 2.5 sk, 4.5 tfl), Jamison Wadley (#12 tkl'r, 5 sk, 3 tfl) and Santez Mays (18 tkl, 5 tfl). While they improved the ypc back to 3.8 they dropped to #6 in rush D and the D had just 20 s'ks. They lose 3, who comb for 24 s't's in 1st Tm OVC NT Brandt Thomas (#7 tkl'r, 7.5 tfl), DE Torrey Davis (16 tkl, 5.5 tfl) and DE Mays (15 tkl, 3.5 tfl). They ret DE's Wadley (3 s'ts, #1 tkl'r) and Monte Lewis (6 s'ts, 21 tkl, 5.5 tfl) and add JC's Marquis George and Aaron Nelson.

LINEBACKERS - The LB unit ret'd 2 s't's in '08 led by Alexander Henderson (#4 tkl'r 3.5 tfl). In '09 the unit ret'd 3 s't's in 1st Tm OVC WLB Henderson (#1 tkl'r, 6.5 tfl), MLB Andrew Ridgeway (#6 tkl'r) and Soph Antonio Bonner (#11 tkl'r, 4 tfl). They also added JC Morrell Jones (PS#469JC). This yr they lose 1st Tm OVC WLB Henderson (#1 tkl'r, 8 tfl) but ret Rover Kevin Dix (#3 tkl'r, 4.5 sk), MLB Ridgeway (#4 tkl'r) along with Jones (#5 tkl'r, 3 tfl) and Bonner #10 tkl'r, 3 tfl), who has 10 comb s'ts at SLB. They also add JC Brannon Byrd (PS#445JC).

DEFENSIVE BACKS - The secondary ret'd 2 s't's in '08 in S Carnell Clark (#5 tkl'r, 9 pd) and S Kenny Walker (#8 tkl'r). They fell 1 spot to #5 in pass D allowing a 10-11 ratio. In '09 they ret'd 3 s't's in 1st Tm OVC S Carnell Clark (#2 tkl'r, 3 tfl, 2 int, 5 pbu), CB TJ Heath (#4 tkl'r, 8 pd) and CB AJ Davis (#5 tkl'r, 3 int, 6 pbu but did lose S Walker (#8 tkl'r, 5 pd). They allowed just 155 ypg passing (#1 OVC) with a 6-9 ratio. They must replace 2nd Tm OVC S Clark (8 tkl'r) and S Josh Cain (#2 tkl'r, 1 int). They ret their top 3 CB's who comb for all 22 s't's in '09 in Davis (23 tkl, 1 int, 4 pbu), Jawaan Booker (#12 tkl'r) and 1st Tm OVC CB Heath (#9 tkl'r), who led with 10 pbu and 6 int. They also ret S Keginald Harris (1 st, 25 tkl, 1 int).

SPECIAL TEAMS - The ST unit ret'd both kickers in '08 but had to replace their top returnmen. In '09 they had to replace both kickers and RS Maurice Dupree who avg 11.4 on PR and 28.3 (1 TD) on KR. The ST unit loses P/K Patrick Tatum who avg 39.7 ypg and hit 7-11 FG as well as KR Wilkerson (24.4). They do return PR Alan Bonner, who led the OVC with a 13.9 avg (1 TD).
