QUARTERBACKS - The Gamecocks had to replace QB Cedric Johnson (1434,57%, 6-5, 437 rush) in '08. They brought in LSU trans Ryan Perrilloux (PS#1) and true frosh Marques Ivory (PS#151). Perrilloux threw for 2,318 (63%, 19-13) and was the #2 rusher (368, 3.1, 7 TD) earning 2nd Tm OVC honors. Ivory added 127 (58%, 2-0) and both returned in '09. Perrilloux threw for 2,350 (58.5%) with an outstanding 23-2 ratio while rushing 443 (4.5. 8TD) and was the OVC OPOY but departs. Ivory started the opener (Perrilloux susp) and in 9 games threw for 315 (65.0%, 4-1) with 50 yds (2.1) rushing. Ivory returns and they add true frosh Coty Blanchard (PS#114).
