POSITION OUTLOOK FOR 2010

QUARTERBACKS - In '08 SIU had to replace 2Y starting QB Nick Hill, who led the conf with 3.175 (71.5%, 28-7, 357 rush). QB Chris Dieker beat out Hill's backup Joe Allaria and started all 12 throwing for 2,083 (57.1%) with a 16-10 ratio (119 rush). Allaria hit 10 of 16 for 85 yds and moved to WR. Dieker returned LY and SIU added Army tránsfer QB Paul McIntosh (PS#94), who is a former Indiana "Mr Football". Dieker started the first 7 before being knocked out (1Q vs YSU) with a broken collarbone and did not return until he came off the bench vs W&M. He threw for 1,326 (58.4%, 10-5) with 77 rush (2.0). McIntosh started the final 6, throwing for 888 (67.2%, 8-3) and was the #2 rusher (588, 6.8, 6 TD). Both return

TY and seemed to pick up the new offense in the spring. **RUNNING BACKS** - In '08 SIU had to replace their top rusher, John Randle (1,074, 5.3, 11 TD) along with FB Rick Burgess. RB Larry Warner, (top returnee, 525, 6.2) led with 1,265 (5.9, 10 TD, AA) and was the #5 rec (203, 7.5) but he departed Y. SIU ret'd 7 of their top 8 (comb 778) incl top returnee Richard White (343, 4.4). They also returned Deji Karim, who was '07's

#3 rusher (386) but míssed '08 with inj. Kárim became the MVFC OPOY rushing for 1,694 (7.1, 18 TD, #4 rec). He set the SIU all-purp record (2,339) and was a Walter Payton Award Finalist but now departs (#6DC, JAX). They ret Lucien Walker (243, 4.4), Steve Strother, who had 154 (4.1) as a true and 1st Tm MVFC FB John Goode. They also add in Pitt transfer Shariff Harris (PS#59).

RECEIVERS - SIU had to replace 5 of their top 6 rec (2,307 comb) in '08 with the top returnee being the #5 recTE Ryan Kernes (268 11.2), but they did add Minn transfer WR Marc Cheatham (PS#161JC).WR Damian Sherman led with just 460 (14.4) and departed. They lost 2 of their top 4 rec but returned everyone else who caught a pass in '08, incl #2 Cheatham (369, 12.7) and #4 Joe Allaria (260, 9.3). This vr they lose 4 of their top 6 incl Cheatham (#5) but return #1, 2nd Tm MVFC WR Allaria (697 .4) and #3 Jeff Evans (319, 17.7)

OFFENSIVE LINE - The OL ret'd 3 st'rs in '08 and added a Ball St transfer but saw their ypc drop for a 2nd straight yr (4.8 to 4.5) and allowed 1 more sk (24, 6.9%) in 2 fewer gms. LY the OL ret'd 4 OL who comb for 36

sts in '08, but lost two 12 gm st'rs in AA LG Aaron Lockwood and 2nd Tm MVFC C Mike Farrell. They increased their ypc to 5.4 and cut the sacks to 14 (4.7%). They lose 3 st'rs but ret 1st Tm MVFC LT David Pickard and 2nd tm MVFC C Bryan Boemer and add JC Jessy McMullin (PS#417JC)

DEFENSIVE LINE - The DL ret'd 2 st'rs in '08 and had one less spot to fill with a move from a 4-3 to a 3-4. The ypc improved from 3.7 to 3.0 and the sk ttl went from 26 to 29. LY SIU lost DE Kendrick Young (8 st, 21 tkl) but ret'd 3 DL who comb for 28 sts. The ypc went up to 3.3 but the D recorded 36 sks. This yr they lose 2 st'rs in NT Chris Arthurs (21 tkl, 4 tfl) and DE Dolapo Adúbifa (28 tkl) but ret DE's Chance Coda 27 tkl, 3.5 tfl), Kyle Russo (25 tkl, 6 sk) and Jason Seaman (22 tkl). LINEBACKERS - The LB unit added a spot in '08 but ret'd 2 st'rs in AA OLB Chauncey Mixon (#1 tkl'r) and 2nd Tm GFC MLB Brandin Jordan. LY they ret'd 3 st'rs in 1st Tm MVFC Jordan (#2), 2nd Tm MVFC Mixon (#3) and Ryan Patton (#4). They lost their sack leader in 2nd Tm MVFC OLB James Cloud (7.5 sk, #5) but added JC Robert Spann (PS#474JC). This yr they lose 5 LB who comb for 49 sts incl 1st tm MVFC Jordan (#1 tkl'r, 5 sk), 2nd tm MVFC OLB Mixon (#8), Kyle Walker (#6, 8 sk), Ryan Patton (#5) and Fred

Wright (#11). They ret Connor James (#7) and

Spann (24 tkl). **DEFENSIVE BACKS** - The secondary had to replace 2 st'rs in '08 and fell from #5 in MVFC pass def to #8 and allowed a 15-16 ratio (13-21 in '07). SIU ret'd 4 who comb for 46 sts in '09 incl AA CB Korey Lindsey and 2nd Tm MVFC SS Marty Rodgers (#1 tkl'r). They improved their ratio to an outstanding 14-23 They lose SS Rodgers (#3 tkl'r) and CB Brandon Williams (#11,9pd) and SLance Caldwell (#13 5 int). They return two 1st tm MVFC DB's in CB Lindsey (#4, 6 int) and FS Mike McElroy (#2) who led the conf with 7 int. They also add in JC TJ Shine (PS#524JC).

SPECIAL TEAMS - In '08 SIU had to

replace a 1st Tm GFC RS (top PR & KR). LY SIU lost 1stTmMVFC RS LarryWarner who avg 11.1 on PR and was #2 in the FCS avg 31.2 ypr with 3 KRTD (tied #1 FCS). They returned 1st Tm MVFC P Scott Ravanesi (43.3) and K Kyle Dougherty, who hit 15 of 23 FG (L/52) in '08. TY they lose 1st tm MVFC P Ravanesi (42.2, 36.8 net), 2nd tm RS Deji Karim (30.9 on KR, 1 TD). They ret 2nd tm MVFC K Dougherty (19 of 25 L/49) and their top PR

COACHES - HC Dale Lennon took over in '08 after 9 vrs as the HC of North Dakota, replacing 7 yr HC Jerry Kill (N Illinois). Lennon was named MVFC COY for the 2nd straight yr. OC Phil Longo leaves after 2 yrs and the new OC is Kalen DeBour who was the HC at 3x NAIA Champ Sioux Falls. DC Bubba Schweigert

enters his 3rd yr here and 8th straight as Lennon's DC. **FORECAST** - The Salukis ret'd 7 off st'rs LY and were in the 2nd yr of the offense but had to replace two AA. While they finished #3 in total Off, they led the MVFC in scoring. They have a new OCTY and must replace conf's OPOY but return 6 st'rs including 3 All-MVFC players and have 2 experienced QB's. SIU only lost 5 def lettermen LY and ret'd 9 def st'rs and 14 of their top 15 tkl'rs. While they remained #4 MVFC in total def, they improved from #4 to #2 in scoring (5.4 ppg less). They return just 3 def st'rs and while they lose 5 of their top 8 tkl'rs they do return two 1st Tm MVFC DB's who combined for 13 int and 12 players who had 20 or more tkls. LY SIU opened with a 3 pt loss to FBS Marshall but then won 11 straight before falling to W&M in the 2nd round of the playoffs. They became the first MVFC tm to go 8-0 in conf play and have won a MVFC record 14 straight conf gms. They have the 2nd longest playoff streak in the FCS (7) but have lost in the opening round in 3 of those trips. The Salukis will face an FBS team for a 7th straight year. They open a new 15,000 seat stadium this year. While they return just 9 st'rs they are still an exp'd team and have the advantage of playing 2 extra weeks LY. They will again be in the hunt for the MVFC crown and should make their 8th straight playoff appearance.
