In their L/gm they rallied from a 21 pt 2H deficit but eventually lost 55-52 in 3OT to RT. QB Gilbert broke the schl rc going 4S 4S 4S 4S 4S while WR Johnson also broke records w/217 (12.1) and 13 yds. Despite playing a top 20 offense, SMU is actually +1 ypg. Memphis is off 2BZ for the 1st time since 2005 and Houston is off 2BZ for the 1st time since 2006. I don't see me yet again as they beat Memphis 25-15. Even in the loss, I have come away impressed with the Tigers each of the last two weeks. However, I think their losing ways continue here as I will call for the rested Ponies to pull the upset of the week.

I do think UW has the better team but you have to wonder how much UW has left in the tank after two huge qms where they came up short.

The Golden Flashes losted the Jaguars in 2011 and they were USA's 2nd ever FBS opponent. The Flashes dominated the 1H with a 26-0 lead and 208-44 yd edge. USA actually rallied in the 2H and only lost 33-25. Kent is on a 2nd str away but is playing their 8th str grm while the Jags come in fresh off a bye. Both teams have had a lot of injuries. The 1H was a 26-0 lead for the Flashes while Kent had to play much of the 1H of the yr w/o AA Archer. LW they nearly pulled the road upset vs Ball St but lost 27-24. Even more costly than the loss, however, was the fact that QB Reardon and RB Durham were lost to inj. Look for the Jags to take advantage here and pick up a solid non-conference win.

UTAH ST 34 NEW MEXICO 27

First meeting. The unfareited yet unranked Cougs still are getting no respect from the nat'l media outside of yours truly. They are off a bye and a HG vs Memphis where I won another best bet on them in their 25-15 win! BYU, on the other hand is not in a good spot here as they just faced the GT option at home and has a huge revenge game on Monday. They may have a chance to get a huge win in relief of impressive fashion but now they must travel down south to the heat and humidity (although Reliant could be closed). UV has been winning with offense, defense and ST's and they are one of the nation's leaders in TO margin. Look for this to go down to the wire as the underdog Cougars are one of my best bets yet again.

Georgia Tech played the inaugural Sun Belt game LW and almost pulled the upset as they lost by only 7 to Troy. They did post an FBS high 422 yards vs Troy but their lack of depth truly shows on the defensive side of the ball where they allowed Troy 634 yards. Now for the first time ever they travel as a conf foe playing a team hungry off a loss that allowed just 192 yards but threw a pair of 70+ yard pick-6's. The Bobcats have won their other 2 home games by 24 ppg (Wyoming & SF Austin) and I don't think they'll be afraid to run it up versus a conf foe as evidenced by home wins LY vs previous WAC foes in New Mexico Tech (66-28) and Idaho (38-7).

MU has won 4 str (three of the last 4 by a td or less) and 9 of 10. LY Dysert was the first QB in NCAA history to pass for over 500 yds and rush for over 100 in the same game and threw for a schl rec 6 tds. MU had leads of 13-0 and 28-14 but AU kept battling back with Miami winning 56-49. They are now historically bad on offense as LW they lost to UMass and get outgained 376-290. Now they take on a Zips team hungry for their first conference win under head coach Bowden. The Zips have lost 30 straight away from home but break the nation's longest road losing streak here as they continue the RedHawks woes.

LY was only mtg in the 166Y, OSU settled for 22 and 30 yd FG's and trailed 14-9 despite making a 211-76 yd edge at the half. The Cowboys got 2 td's and a FG to open the 3Q, added another 27 yd FG and won easily 36-14. The Cowboys come in of a bye. Both teams have not lived up to their preseason hype as OSU has already been upset and TCU has not impressed me in any of their 6 games ty. LW was no exception as they beat lowly KS 27-17 as QB Boykin only has a 5-4 ratio on the yr. While OSU has "struggled" on off, they are still avg 38 ppg and 445 ypg and I will agree with my computer's forecast here.

STANFORD 34 UCLA 21

First meeting. NMST is off a bye while Rice is on a 3rd straight out. LRW Rice was in UTSA 27-21. While the final stat line shows they were outF'd 24-15 and outgained 434-340, they did lead 27-7 entering the 4Q. They have won 3 str gms but all have been by single digits. NMST has played well early at home in each of their 3 prev gms (outscored only 47-37 in 1H) but a D that is all 579 ypg and an incredible 341 rush ypg (7.2i) continues to wear down in the 2H. While Rice is clearly the better tm I do think New Mexico St keeps it closer than what my computer projects as they have the large situational edge.
