## POSITION OUTLOOK FOR 2014

**QUARTERBACKS** - In '12 UC had to replace their #3 career passer, Zach Collaros (highest comp% in UC hist, 61.9%). Munchie Legaux (PS#30) split time with PS#28 Jordan Luallen when Collaros missed 3 gms in '11. Those 2 both ret'd and joined Brendon Kay (PS#42, 3 knee surgeries career) Legaux threw for 1,716 (52%, 13-9, 335 rush) in '12. He was benched in the 3Q vs Syr (gm 8) and Kay took over and brought the deep ball back to the offense. In just 5 sts he threw for 1,298 (63%, 10-2, 306 rush). Luallen ply'd Wildcat QB (51 yds rush, 1 pass). LY Kay was bothered by a shoulder inj in Aug and Legaux began as the st'r. Legaux, however, was OFY in Wk 2 and Kay retook the job. While Kay was bothered by the inj all year, after 9 gms he was #1 in the FBS at 74.1%. Kay threw for 3,302 (22-12) and he reset the school comp% record (66.3%). Luallen hit 8-11-129 (220 rush 4.7). Bennie Conej ply'd in 3 (6-7-84) and 6 players took at least one QB snap. It's interesting that Brian Kelly had a tie to TY's likely starting QB. Gunner Kiel (PS#1) opted to transfer from ND and Kelly says he reminds him of Tony Pike (long, athletic, escapability, strong arm). Munchie Legaux (miss spring) returns and they add in PS#83JC Jarred Evans (IFS). TY Kay, Luallen & Conej depart but I think this unit is still in pretty good shape but may come up a little short of Kay's stats.

**RUNNING BACKS** - In '12 they had to replace Isaiah Pead (B2B 1,000 yds, now with Rams) and then-HC Butch Jones planned on an RB by committee. George Winn changed those plans with 1,334 (5.5). Diminutive but speedy Ralph David Abernathy (5'7" 161, PS#137) had 366 (5.3). LY they had to replace Winn and Tuberville said Abernathy was not an every down back. He finished with 518 (3.9, 177 rec). Hosey Williams, who rushed for 1,269 at JC, didn't start any gms but led w/655 (5.7) despite 0 att in 2 gms. Soph Tion Green (PS#71) had 70 (4.4) as a true and was #3 w/412 (4.5) LY. TY the top 3 all return with Abernathy working at the Slot in the spring. Not listed below is FB Jared Golden (6'1" 240 Jr) who had 1 st and 50 (16.7) LY. I give them a shot at uncovering their 4th 1,000 yd rusher in 5 years.

**RECEIVERS** - LY the Bearcats had to replace their top 2 receivers (comb 1263, 16.0), including Travis Kelce (UC's all-time single ssn TE yds). They ret'd just 1 of their top 4 in Anthony McClung (#3 539, 15.9). While McClung unus' st'd 6, he led UC w/939 (13.0). Jr Shaq Washington (PS#89, 6 rec 1st 2Y) was #1 in rec w/78 and #2 yds w/783 (10.0). Chris Moore (PS#95) who had 113 (28.2) as a rFr was #3 w/645 (14.3) while soph Max Morrison was #5 w/447 (15.4). Surprisingly 6'6" Ark

transfer Mekale McKay (PS#147) was only #4 w/485 but led with a 30.3 ypc! Not listed below are Javon Harrison (6'1" 200 rFr, PS#74QB) and Johnny Holton (6'3" 190 Jr, PS#43JC). TY they lose 2nd Tm AAC McClung and TE Blake Annen (8 st, 183, 11.4) but are a much more exp'd unit.

**OFFENSIVE LINE** - Butch Jones' O-lines improved each of his 3Y with his first year ('10) at 157 (4.7, 33 sk) and in his 3rd yr at 201 ypg rush (5.3, 15 sk). That '12 version did only have 2 st'rs back (28 car st). LG Austen Bujnoch and LT Eric Lefeld both earned 1st Tm BE and LY they lost C Dan Sprague over the summer but still had 4 st'rs back (70 car sts). Despite the veteran group and the soft schedule, UC's numbers dropped to 168 ypg (4.2, 17 sk). TY they lose 3rd Tm AAC RG Sam Longo (PS#47, 2Y st'r), LG Bujnoch (9 st til inj, 3Y st'r) and Andre Cureton (7 st). They have 3 ret st'rs (71 car st) and after underachieving LY, should at least match '13's numbers.

**DEFENSIVE LINE** - In '11 OLB Walter Stewart moved to DE full-time and their top 8 all ret'd (two 300 lb Sr DT's) making it their most veteran unit in yrs. They allowed just 95 rush ypg (2.7, #6 FBS) with 46 sks (led nation in tfl). In '12 they had to replace a BE co-DPOY DT (#2DC), a #3DC and 2 bkps. The unit had 22 sks in the first 7 but then Stewart was OFY (9 sk L6). UC's numbers slipped to 136 ypg rush (3.8). LY they had to replace 2nd Tm BE Stewart, a 1st Tm BE DE and 2 other DL (comb 12 st, 70 tkl). DT Camaron Beard (11 st '12) lost his spot (4 tkl) so they basically had just 1 st'r back. DC Art Kaufman believed in speed over size and thought it was a deep unit (rotated 10 to 12) and Tuberville felt the DL would be a strength. UC improved to 104 ypg rush (3.2) with 35 sks. TY they lose 1st Tm AAC DT Jordan Stepp (13 st, 45 tkl, 6 sk, 2 tfl), DT Mitch Meador (F/2 st, 12 tkl, 2.5 tfl), DT Adam Dempsey (10 st, 29 tkl, 3.5 sk, 4.5 tfl) and Marques Aiken (24 tkl). While they lose 2 st'rs, they ret 2nd Tm AAC DE Silverberry Mouhon (9.5 sk) and are in the 2nd year of the system. While they can't improve much upon LY's numbers, this unit is more exp'd.

**LINEBACKERS** - In '12 UC had to replace 1st Tm BE JK Schaffer (1st in UC hist top 100 tkl 3Y straight) and a bkp (11 tkl). They ret'd 2 st'rs (#5, #11 tkl'rs). Greg Blair had just 1 tkl in '11 (inj) but emerged as the leader in '12 w/138 tkl (9 tfl) earning 1st Tm BE. They all'd just 18.5 ppg (best s/95!) LY they lost 1 st'r (3rd Tm BE, #2 tkl'r), ret'd their #1 and #5 tkl'rs and added in Florida St transfer Jeff Luc (PS#4). UC did improve their ypg all'd from 388 to 316 but the ppg went up to 21.0. Surprisingly Blair only earned 2nd Tm AAC (#1 tkl'r w/106, 7 tfl). Nick Temple (#5 '12) was #2 (3rd Tm AAC) while Luc was #7 (43). TY they lose their top guy Blair (13 st) and Corey Mason (21 tkl) but have 4 of the top 6 back and add in PS#41 true frosh Kevin Mouhon who Tuberville called the best HS LB in the country. They should come near LY's standards.

**DEFENSIVE BACKS** - UC had 3 st'rs back in '12 and moved all the way up to #20 in my PDR (57%, 13-16) despite allowing 252 pass ypg. LY they had to replace a 3rd Tm BE CB (#3 tkl'r), SS (#6 tkl'r) and 5 other DB's (comb 89 tkl). Trenier Orr st'd the first 2 at CB before being inj and OFY but the less exp'd secondary still did well finishing #35 (58%, 16-13). TY they lose 2 st'rs in FS Arryn Chenault (13 st, #4 tkl'r, 7 pbu) and 2nd Tm AAC CB Deven Drane (10 st, #10 tkl'r, 3 int, 5 pbu) but return 6 of the top 8 making them a little more exp'd.

**SPECIAL TEAMS** - In '11 UC was #12 in my ST rankings and had most of the key ply'rs back in '12 but surprisingly fell to #81. LY they only had to replace their P (35.3 net) and KO spec (36-75). K Tony Miliano (PS#23) hit 17-22 in '12. He surprisingly struggled in '13 hitting just 7-17 fg's (L44) while also adding KO duties (23-75). New P John Lloyd (PS#42) avg 42.7 with Brendon Kay's pooch punts avg 38.6 (tm net #119, 33.0). They

RS true frosh Andrew Gantz (PS#23). They were -9.9 on PR and +1.5 on KR. UC finished all the way down at #124. TY most of their key players are back and after 2 straight drops, I look for a solid climb in '14.

**COACHES** - To say that Cincinnati knows how to hire HC's is an understatement. Prior to reeling in Tommy Tuberville LY the 3 previous hires are currently at Mich St (Mark Dantonio), Notre Dame (Brian Kelly) and Tennessee (Butch Jones). Tuberville's HC exp includes Ole Miss ('95-'98), Auburn ('99-'08) and TT ('10-'12). After a 13-0 ssn in '04 he swept the COY awards. Twenty-seven yr vet Eddie Gran was an OC for the 1st time LY (prev 3Y Fla St RB/ST cch) and was also at Tenn ('09) and Auburn ('99-'08). The new co-DC's are Hank Hughes who spent the L13Y at UConn (DC LY & '02-'04) and Robert Prunty who was UC's DE cch LY. He spent the previous 3Y at TT (DE cch) where he was named the B12 recruiter of the year each of the L2 ssns.

## PHIL'S FORECAST

Cincinnati has now won or shared 4 of the last 6 Big East/AAC Titles. In Mark Dantonio's final year ('06) UC reached 8 wins for the first time s/97 but in Brian Kelly's 3 yrs they reached 10, 11 and 12 wins finishing #17, #17 and #8 despite not being ranked s/76! The UC record for points in a ssn had been 409 and Kelly's '07 squad had 472. The '09 season (502 pts!) was remarkable as UC had just 1 ret st'r on D but they still went 12-0 in the reg ssn and was as high as #4. I pointed out in '10 that there were many factors pointing down (4 net close wins, +9 TO's, new HC). UC was still picked #2 in the Big East media poll (#26 AP). HC Butch Jones pointed out that they ret'd only 12 players who played on Off or Def in the Sugar Bowl (majority '09 tm gone). They slumped to 4-8. That '10 squad was -15 in TO's but were +36 ypg in the BE (3rd best despite 2-5). In '11 the D ret'd 10 st'rs and the offense had both Collaros and Pead back. My final sentence in '11 was that UC made my MIT and was a legitimate contender for the Big East Title. UC was +12 in TO's and improved to 10-3 (#25). Butch Jones left for Tenn and they made a solid hire in Tommy Tuberville. In '12 they tied for 1st in the Big East but were only +6.3 ypg (4th best). They were +9 in TO's and had a Stock Market Indicator of -3.0 but I did point out that with a light schedule they could be favored in their first 9 and that they were. UC only led Purdue 14-7 at half but rolled to a 42-7 win. They were a td+ fav at Illinois but got destroyed 45-17. After waxing NWSU, they surprisingly were tied with lowly Miami. Oh 0-0 until a td w/4:55 left got them out front (only won 14-0). USF beat them without scoring an offensive td, 26-20 as UC had a 350-241 yd edge. They beat 3 teams who finished with losing records in Temple, Conn and Memphis. At home vs SMU, they trailed 10-0 after 1Q with SMU dominating early. UC won 28-25. They took on a banged up Rutgers secondary and QB Kay hit 24-38-408 in a 52-17 win. They had a 573-278 yd edge and beat Houston but in the final game at Nippert Stadium before the remodel, in an electric atmosphere, they lost for the 2nd year in the row in OT to L'ville. In the bowl they were whipped by NCar 39-17 to fall to 9-4. TY they go from 12 ret st'rs to 13 and were -7 in TO's LY. UC finished #9 in the NCAA on D all'g 316 ypg and return 6 of their top 9 tacklers. All of their HG's TY will be played at Paul Brown Stadium (Nippert renovated). The Bearcats avoid UCF in AAC play and figure to be favored in 10 of their 12 games.

Cincinnati's Nippert Stadium will not be used for the 2014 season due to renovations. The Bearcats will play at Paul Brown Stadium, the home of the NFL's CIN Bengals.

**Bonus:** Only 4 FBS tms not playing the wknd of Aug 30th. UC is the ONLY one off the 1st 2 wks.  
**Bonus:** The Bearcats have won 12 straight home openers by 35 ppg.

UT will already be playing in their 3rd gm. UC has dropped 3 str incl a 29-23 loss in the L/gm ('12). UC trailed 13-0 but took their only lead 20-19 w/2:08 3Q. They all'd a 91 yd KR td :13 sec later.

LY in this rivalry it was 0-0 until UC went 79/16pl (7:41 DOP) scoring a td w/4:55 left. Bearcats have won 5 straight hosting the RedHawks (last loss here '02), winning by an avg score of 42-15.

Cincinnati is 0-9 in Columbus incl a 37-7 loss the LTH ('06, also the L/meeting). Just the 5th meeting s/1932 for these in-state schools (109 losses aply). Bearcats are 2-8 in road openers s/'04.

UC is 5-1 s/'00 incl a 34-21 win LY on a Wed night. UC only led 14-7 at HT despite a 218-58 yd edge. In the 2H the Tigers cut the deficit to 7 & 6 late 4Q but both times the Bearcats answered w/td drives.

Cincinnati is 1-10 (only series win was in 1947, 1st meeting). LTH ('89) the Bearcats were shutout 56-0 & in the last 3 trips the Bearcats have been outscored by a combined 151-3.

LY was the schools only meeting (UC had 10 days to prepare). Tuberville is 4-0 as a HC vs the Mustangs beating them in '97 & '98 (at Gerald J Ford Stadium) while at Ole Miss, in '10 at TT & here LY.

UC is 6-2 but lost LY. UC trailed 13-0 until a 22 yd td pass w/10:04 2Q. After that they all'd 13 str incl a 10 yd FR td, to trail 26-6 into the 4Q. UC got to within 6 but their inside failed w/2:02.

L/gm ('02) was UC's L/trip to New Orleans vs UT. They are 1-7 all-time on the road vs the Green Wave, only win in '76. Into '14, the Bearcats are 15-5 their L/20 conf AG's incl 3-1 in their 1st ssn of the AAC.

**Bonus:** Cincinnati is 28-7 vs non-conf (reg ssn) opponents since 2007.

L/gm ('04) EC cut it to 24-19 with a 75 yd td pass w/5:20 3Q.  
UC held EC to just 27 yds their L/4 poss & ran out L/8:05.

LTH UC led 14-0 but Conn cut it to 4 after 3Q's. UC all'd just 39 yds, got 2 int's & scored 13 pts in the 4Q.

UC has won 4 str (L/loss in '85). LTH the Bearcats led 24-3 at HT and maintained a 14+ pt lead the entire 2H (won 34-10).

UC is 8-2 s/'75 incl a 24-17 win LY. The Bearcats never trailed & led 24-7 4Q (UH got 10 pts in L/5:22 incl a 15 yd FR td).
