POSITION OUTLOOK FOR 2010

QUARTERBACKS - In '08 EIU ret'd former WY transfer QB Bodie Reeder, who started the last 9 in '07 throwing for 1,726 (65%, 10-5). He started all 12 in '08 throwing for 1,931 (63%, 13-7) and returned LY along with rFr Doug Reynolds. They added Iowa transfer Jake Christensen (PS#6, 12 sts in '07) for the fall. Christensen started all 12 throwing for 2,204 (58.3%, 19-11) and was 2nd Tm OVC but departs along with Reeder (84 yds). They return former JC Brandon Large, (RS here LY), Reynolds, who played in 2 (5 rush att) LY, but was inj in the spring, rFr Shandonta Travis and add 3 true fresh in the fall.

RUNNINGBACKS - The Panthers ret'd 5 of their top 6 rushers in '08 led by Travorus Bees (612, 5.8) but lost a 1,000 yd rusher. In '09 they lost 1st Tm OVC RB Bees (1086, 5.7) but ret'd former Florida trans Chevon Walker (PS#37) who was #2 with 365 (4.9) along with #3 Desmin Ward (322, 3.5, EIU rec 11 TD's). They also added Florida trans PS#23 Mon Williams (PS#23) and Mich trans Jimmy Potempa (PS#256), who split time between RB and WR. This yr they ret their top 5 rushers led by 2nd Tm OVC RB Williams (870, 4.6, 9 TD), Walker (326, 4.9), Potempa (222, 3.8) and Ward, who's numbers dropped to just 107 (3.3) as he played most of the yr at FB.

RECEIVERS - In '08 EIU had to replace 3 of their top 5 rec incl a former Minn transfer who led with 777 (14.1, 9 TD) in '07. Their top returnee was #2 Alicus Nozinger (367, 9.9) and they dropped from #5 to #7 in passing. In '09 they ret'd just 2 of their top 9 rec #1 Charles Graves (561, 14.0) and #6 Lorenzo Ricks (167, 11.9). They moved up to #4 in pass off. They look to ret everyone, who caught a pass in '09 incl 6 with 200+ yds. They are led by Ricks (381, 20.1), Kenny Whittaker (358, 12.3) and Graves (333, 13.9) and also return RB/WR Potempa, who led with 32 receptions (238, 7.4).

OFFENSIVE LINE - In '08 the OL lost 2 str's, who comb for 17 sts in '07 but ret'd 5 with starting exp led by 1st tm OVC RG Chaz Milliard. The OL suffered the majority of LY's injuries as 7 different combo's started the F/8 gms and they dropped from #4 to #2 in rushing as their ypc went from 4.6 to 3.9 and they allowed 12 more sks (22, 7.8%). That made '09's OL one of the deepest as all 5 str's ret incl 1st tm OVC RG Chaz Milliard (only one to st all 12) and ret 9 with starting exp. Surprisingly, especially with 3 former FBS RB's they fell to #8 in rushing with a 3.4 ypc and allowed 32 sks (17.4%). They lose 4 OL who comb for 41 sts LY incl 1st Tm OVC C Milliard and 2nd Tm OVC LT Chris Campbell. The OL ret 2 str's in 2 yr st LG Eric Zink and 2nd Tm OVC RG Willie Henderson, who moved to C in the spg. They may add some transfers to bolster the line over the summer.

DEFENSIVE LINE - The DL lost 2 str's in '08 but ret'd 8 of the DL's 10 man rotation. However, EIU dropped from #2 to #8 in rush

D as they their ypc allowed went from 4.0 to 4.6 despite the D having 2 more sks (17). In '09 they lost 3 all-OVC incl AA Pierre Walters (#6 tkl', 16.5 tfl). They ret'd 1 str in DT Andre Lima (#13 tkl', 8 tfl) along with backups DT Trevor Frericks (16 tkl, 5 tfl) and DE Perry Burge (13 tkl, 4 tfl). Surprisingly they moved up to #5 in rush D and their 3.8 ypc was the lowest in 4 yrs and the D increased their sk tfl to 24. They lose 2 str's in DT Lima (#12 tkl'r) and 1st Tm OVC DT Frericks (#6 tkl'r) who was #3 in the OVC with 16 tfl. They ret 5, who had a comb 26 sts in '09 led by 2nd Tm OVC DE Burge (#10 tkl'r), who led with 5 sks and also ret former Navy transfer Mike Letton (PS#456).

LINEBACKERS - In '08 the LB unit had to replace 2 str's, who were the top 2 tkl'r's incl Buck Buchanan Awd finalist Donald Thomas (#1 tkl'r) but ret'd 2 LB who comb for 12 sts in Jack Kosinski (#9 tkl'r) and James Larson (#7 tkl'r). In '09 they lost both Kosinski (#8 tkl'r) and Larson (#7 tkl'r). This yr the unit ret'd 3 LB who each had 6 sts in Cory Leman (#3 tkl'r), Nick Nasti (#11) and Alain Marcelin (#9) along with Sean Campbell (1 st, 13 tkl, 4 tfl). They ret 5, who comb for all 36 sts in '09 in SLB Nasti (#1 tkl'r), WLB Leman (#2), MLB Gordy Kickels (#3, 4.5 tfl), Campbell (#7) and Marcelin (15 tkl).

DEFENSIVE BACKS - The secondary ret'd 3 str's in '08 in FS Adrian Arrington (#3 tkl'r), and two 2nd Tm OVC DB's in SS Ke'Andre Sams (#4 tkl'r) and CB Rashad Haynes (#5, 5 int, 6 pbu). They also ret'd S Seymour Loftman, who was 2nd Tm OVC in '06 but missed '07 with inj. They improved from #5 to #1 in pass D with a 12-2 ratio. In '09 they lost Sams (#1 tkl'r) but ret'd 3 str's in FS Loftman (#8 tkl'r) and CB's Haynes (#4, 4 int, 8 pbu) and CJ James (6 sts, 29 tkl) along with backup Arrington (#10 tkl'r). They finished #2 in pass D with a 13-11 tie. They lose 3 who comb for 20 sts in '09 in FS Loftman (#8 tkl'r), CB Shelton Penrow (#9, 4 pd) and ROV Arrington (#11 tkl'r). They ret 1st Tm OVC CB CJ James (#5 tkl'r, 5 int) and 2nd Tm OVC CB Haynes (#4, 12 pd) along with ROV Bobson Mercier (18 tkl), who started 5 of the L/6.

SPECIAL TEAMS - The ST unit only lost their top PR in '08. In '09 they only ret'd P Kevin Cook (39.7). K Austin Signor was 1st tm OVC (14-22 FG) but departs. They ret their top 2 RS in CB Haynes (420 ret yds) and WR Ricks (332, 1 TD) along with P Cook (42.0).

COACHES - HC Bob Spoo is in his 23rd ssn and is #5 all time in FCS playoff appearances (9) by a HC. Roy Wittke had been OC here from '90-'02 and ret'd in '08 at the same spot and was named asst HC in '09. Roc Bellantoni returns for his 10th ssn as DC.

FORECAST - The Panthers ret'd 7 off str's in '09 incl a 2 yr str but he was replaced by 1 of 3 FBS transfers. While they remained #4 in scoring they moved up 1 spot to #5 in total off this yr. They again return 7 str's but will have a new QB and ret just 2 OL str's but return their top 8 rushers and top 15 receivers. EIU's def ret'd 6 str's in '09 but improved their numbers across the board and while they remained #3 in scoring the improved from #6 to #2 in tfl def. Last year EIU was off their first losing ssn since '04 and saw their streak of 3 straight playoff appearances end. The Panthers started '09 4-0 but fell to OVC rival ECU, which looked like it would cost them the OVC Crown. After a loss to Penn St they won their next 4 including handing JSU their only conf loss and only had to beat 3-7 Tenn St to win the OVC crown but were upset. They still won as ECU lost their finale 3 days later. They then lost in the 1st rd of the playoffs for an 8th straight time. The Panthers lose just 15 lettermen but that incl 8 str's, a former 2 yr starting QB and a 1st Tm OVC K. The Panthers seem to always gain some trans over the summer and 1 or 2 in the right spot could be enough to give EIU their 2nd straight OVC title.
