**OFFENSE** - The offense continued its transition from rushing towards passing and of course was aided by the addition of PS#1 Ryan Perrilloux. They improved by 70 ypg and 4 ppg despite going from +12 to -1 in TO's. Perrilloux (2318, 63.0%, 19-13 ratio) added 368 rush yds. They do lose a 2 yr starter at RB (815, 6.4 LY) but the top returnee Brandon George (206, 6.4) proved in the spring he's ready for the feature role. Soph Calvin Middleton (75, 4.7) who played well as a true and JUCO Jamaal Young will both steal some snaps. FB Alphonso Freeney (169, 5.8) can do more than block. Two TE's return and both are used as rec's in Eric Johns (188, 10.4, 5 TD's) and Deonte Carter (146, 13.3). In '08 the Gamecocks lost their top 3 WR's and while they lose their #1 this year their #2 (James Wilkerson, 516, 16.1) & #3 (Jeffrey Cameron, 297, 12.9) are back. The newcomers are exciting and several will see action and Greg Smith may be an opening day starter. Three starters were back on the OL in '08 and they are now accustomed to the different blocking schemes as they improved by a whole yard per carry rush. This year 3 starters are back in C Reggie Wade, LT Curt Porter and LG Matt Jones. HC Crowe stated that an OT was a main priority in the offseason and true Fr Ricky Clemons will play early and rFr Tori Mobley should earn a starting spot this year.

**DEFENSE** - The defense returned six starters LY (just 4 & 5 the previous two years) and despite allowing almost the same amount of yards they only allowed 21.7 ppg. This year the team returns 7 of the top 8 and 18 of the top 20 tacklers. The defense plays a 3-4 and all have starting exp with Brandt Thomas (34 tkl, 2.5 sk, 4.5 tfl), Jamison Wadley (30 tkl, 5 sk, 3 tfl) and

Santez Mays (18 tkl, 5 tfl). They add in two physical pass rushing JUCO's that will contribute. Two LB's were back LY and this season 3 return including 1st Tm OVC and #1 tackler Alexander Henderson (103 tkl, 6.5 tfl). Also back are Andrew Ridgeway (41 tkl) and Soph Antonio Bonner (31 tkl, 4 tfl). The secondary ret'd 2 starters and held opp's to 55.6% comp LY and this year 3 are back and they finished as the #2, #4 and #5 tkl'rs. They're led by 1st Tm OVC S Carnell Clark (66 tkl, 3 tfl, 2 int, 5 pbu) and CB's TJ Heath (42 tkl, 8 pd) and AJ Davis (41 tkl, 3 int, 6 pbu).

**SPECIAL TEAMS** - This unit will need a total overhaul. The kicking spots should be able to top LY's 36.1 punting avg and 7-9 FG's (long 48). The losses are huge in the return game as departed WR Maurice Dupree avg 11.4 on PR and 28.3 on KR.

**COACHES** - HC Jack Crowe enters his 9th season here. He spent 3 years as Arkansas' HC. OC Ronnie Letson is in his 6th season while DC Greg Stewart is in his 19th year here and 10th as DC.

**FORECAST** - JSU is an outstanding 22-10 in OVC play the last 4 years. In '07 they were +11.6 ypg in OVC play but were a fortunate +12 in TO's and went 5-3. Last year they had just 12 ret starters but thanks to the amazing addition of PS#1 QB Ryan Perrilloux they went against the Turnovers=Turnaround trend and improved their record to 6-2 and were +48 ypg in conf action. This year they have 16 returning starters which is the most in over 5 years and not only is Perrilloux back but so are 18 of the top 20 tacklers! The special teams are my biggest concern. Last year they had to play all the top teams on the road and now get them at home and they are my OVC favorite.
